

## **EAA Chapter 1378 Meeting Minutes**

### **October 20, 2015**

1. There were eleven (11) members attending: Steve Glover, Danner Martin, Lonnie and Debbie Hitchcock, Jim Dorroh, Van Sliger, Wayne Hubbs, Jerry Nelson, Dewey Young, Ron and Alice Hurt.
2. A “thank you” was given to Lonnie and Debbie Hitchcock for bringing a fine barbeque meal for all to enjoy.
3. Dewey Young had to leave for another meeting, and Wayne Hubbs gave the following Treasurer’s report: expenditures included \$106.99 to pay for UCRA luncheon; \$50.48 for Young Eagles office supplies; \$10.99 for YE postage; and \$80.34 for food. Food Account balance is \$759.60; Regular Account balance is \$4,226.04; there are now 26 paid members; 4 members have paid 2016 dues
4. The YE Rally at Livingston is rescheduled for Saturday, October 31<sup>st</sup>. Additional volunteers will be needed for flying, registering, and for marshaling kids to & from aircraft.
5. A question was asked about sponsoring another Young Eagles Rally on November 14 at KSRB. No decision was made.
6. The next meeting will be on Tuesday, November 17 at 7 pm. Officers for 2016 will be discussed and hopefully elected. Danner Martin has volunteered to be the 2016 Chapter Treasurer; Steve Glover would like to only have one office, either Chapter Secretary or YE Coordinator. Members are requested to consider volunteering for one of the officer positions.
7. The date for the Christmas party is to be on Tuesday, December 15 at the meeting room beginning at 6 pm.

8. Suggestions were made as to possible uses of EAA Chapter 1378 funds: EAA shirts for members; reducing dues from \$30 per year to \$10 per year; remodeling of the front-section of Hangar 1 for EAA use; purchase of a video/computer projector for programs. No decisions were made.

9. Capt. Steve Neer (Commander) and Lt. Matt Isbell (Deputy Commander) gave updates on Civil Air Patrol activities in Emergency Services and Cadet Leadership. Lt. Stephen Glover talked about his training in July for becoming a CAP Mission Pilot. In addition, pictures of cadets doing aerospace education activities and cleaning up around the airport were shown.
