C. EAA Chapter 1378 Meeting Minutes - July 18, 2015

1. Eleven (11) dues-paying members attended including Dean Adcock, Steve Glover, Lonnie Hitchcock, Debbie Hitchcock, Dewey Young, Jim Dorroh, Donn Vance, Michael Carpenter, Frank Ferree, Jerry Nelson, and Wayne Hubbs.

2. Minutes from previous meetings were distributed and approved.

3. The Treasurer's report was given. There is \$4187.50 in the checking account; the disbursements were: (1) to Civil Air Patrol for \$100 for emergency services training; (2) to Steve Glover for \$60.27 for office supplies and aerospace education materials for future Young Eagles Rallies. There is cash on hand for food of \$947.00

4. For future YE Rallies, it was again stated that Shell Aviation gives 100 gallons of fuel to each airport per year to have community events. A YE Rally is tentatively scheduled for Livingston on Saturday, September 12.

5. The next YE Rally will be held at Smithville on August 8. Volunteers will be needed for flying and for registering and marshaling people on the ground. Tables, chairs, and water will be needed at Smithville. Steve Glover will bring computer and printer for certificates to be printed. Debbie Hitchcock will check into having notices placed in the Smithville paper and on the radio there.

6. It was suggested that a Poker Run be held on 3rd Saturday in September. There will be a \$20 entry fee and playing cards can be picked up at the following airports: Upper Cumberland KSRB, Smithville 0A3, McMinnville KRNC, Livingston 8A3, and Gainesboro 1A7. Lunch will be provided at noon.

7. The first Friday of each month the Upper Cumberland Regional Airport has been holding a cook-out with hamburgers, hotdogs, and drinks. A motion was made, seconded, and approved for the EAA Chapter 1378 to sponsor a future meal at a cost of \$125 - \$150.
