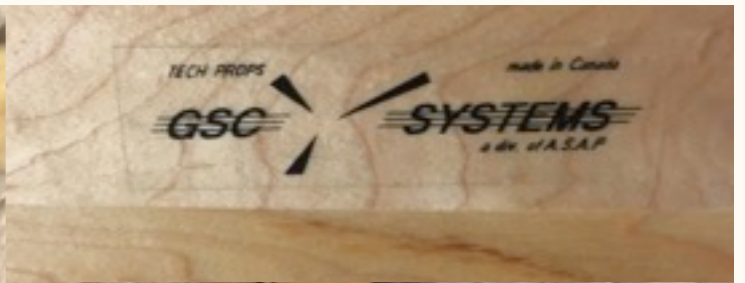
That covers most of the items for the month, but we would love to hear from you if you have a topic of discussion.
