
This is definitely "beyond-the-ropes" and can only be done on the computer.





U.S.A.F. MUSEUM 'PLANE TALKS'

Speaking of U.S.A.F. Museum, "Plane Talks" occur a few times a year and allow visitors the opportunity to talk to veterans, active duty, former pilots, crew members, engineers, navigators, etc. These experts will be stationed in the galleries near the aircraft or exhibit that relates to their expertise. These Plane Talks programs often occur on the anniversary of a significant Air Force or military event.



Last year I happened to visit the USAF Museum on one of these "Plane Talk" days. I spoke with two F-4 pilots, one of which, during the Cold War, flew the East Berlin route with a side-looking radar to keep a close eye for any suspicious activity.

I also talked with a navigator of a Vietnam era C-130 gunship. He used an electrical device to pick-up the spark plug signals from the trucks on the ho chi minh trail. He then directed the aircraft to intercept. After this, his job was done, so a few times we went back to the rear ramp. This is where a Private was stationed on the open ramp. His job was to call out the anti-aircraft coming up; whether it was of no concern or whether they should turn NOW!! The navigator told me the "no concern" rounds were very close, and the turn NOW rounds just barely missed the plane. The navigator had a newfound respect for the job the Private was doing back there.

Upcoming "Plane Talks" days are November 11 – Veterans Day, and December 7 – Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day.
