CHAPTER PROGRAM



Talking with Air Traffic Controllers can be helpful, rather than feeling embarrassed, in finding solutions if you inadvertently end up in suspect conditions. We also discussed a potential EGT/CHT situation. Is this a harbinger of engine problems? Press on, divert, land immediately?

We talk other flying topics, generally one or two ideas suggested by EAA National, and then whatever news, safety or Riverview information members find of interest.


