HINTS FOR HOMEBUILDERS


THANKS BRIAN

June 11 **147** Y.E.'s flown, Greenville, GAAA, (6D6) EAA 145




After 30 years of Young Eagle rallies, 2.3 million young people have flown by EAA chapters. EAA Chapter 145 contributed over **5,000** young people flown. And Dick Foster has flown **2,012** Young Eagle himself, putting him in the top 15 of all Y.E. pilots. WOW!!

FYI: During the 2022 Young Eagle rallies in West Michigan, 12 EAA145 chapter pilots flew an average of 20 Young Eagles each and earned a recognition pin from EAA.

We may not be done yet; There is a possible YE event on October 22 at Sparta (8D4) hosted by EAA704, Chuck Hazekamp. EAA145 is ready to help, stand by for more information.


