The website contains activities, courses, seminars and webinars. Most courses award WINGS or AMT credit. Most courses are free. However, if there is a cost, it will be shown by displaying the word "Cost" in the COST column. As you progress, there is an area that shows your current phase of WINGS.

Under the "Online Resources" tab, there are resources for pilots and for mechanics. There are many links to broaden your education and information: such as aircraft & airworthiness, forms, various pilot resource links, links to the FAR & AIM, etc

There are sections for Advisory Circulars, a listing of Airworthiness Directives (ADs) for your type of airplane, Aviation Mechanics Bulletins, etc.

The FAASTeam website is truly a one-stop shop for all your aviation knowledge needs.
