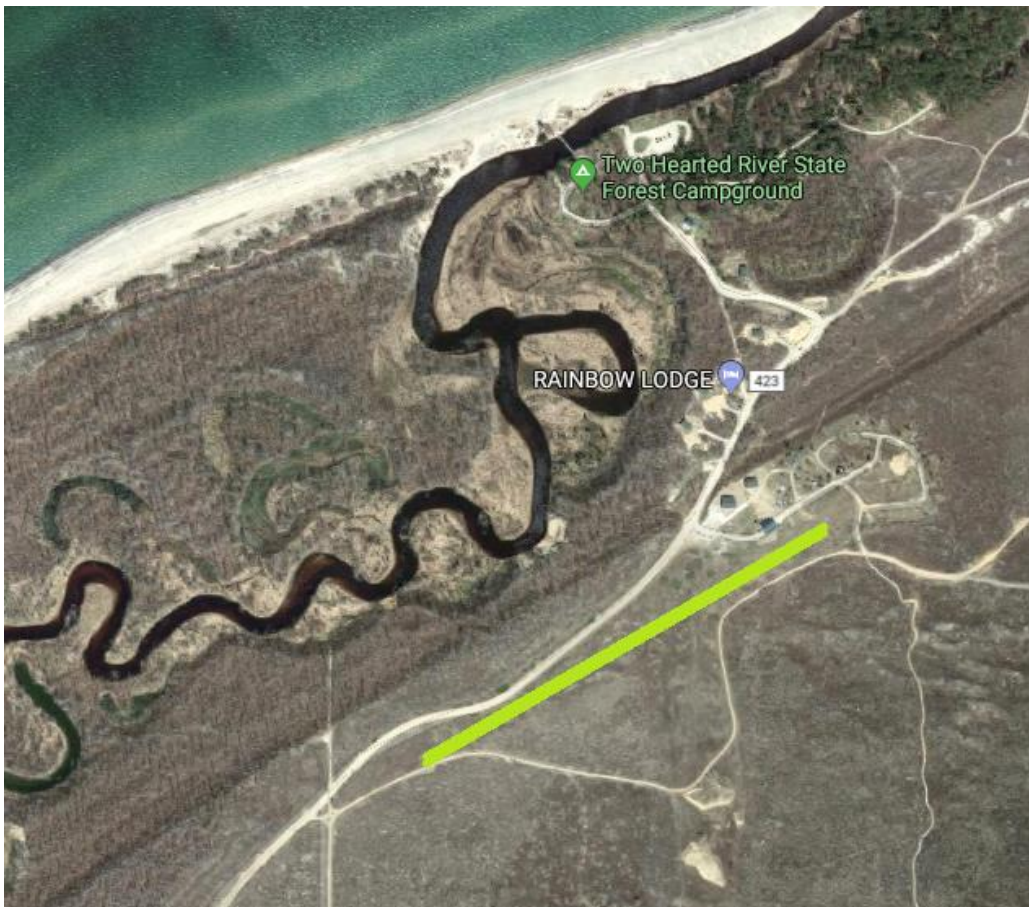
RIVERVIEW OPEN HOUSE
