The Saskatchewan EAA chapter has received a partially completed Zenair CH701 STOL aircraft donated by the estate of Richard Paice a Regina private pilot. Richard had been working on the project since 2007 when he attended a Rudder Building Workshop at the Zenith factory in Mexico, Missouri.

Sadly Richard passed away in 2016, it was his wish that the project be donated to our EAA chapter.

We have picked up what appears to be a complete kit. The wings and tail are completed to the pre-cover inspection stage. The fuselage has not been started but the panels are predrilled. Fuel tanks, landing gear and wheels

are also included, as well as Subaru EA81 auto engine with a re-drive mounted.

I hope to use this project to build and promote our chapter and finish the plane in a fashion that would make Richard proud.
