The Chapter's activity for the month was to hold a Young Eagles Rally.

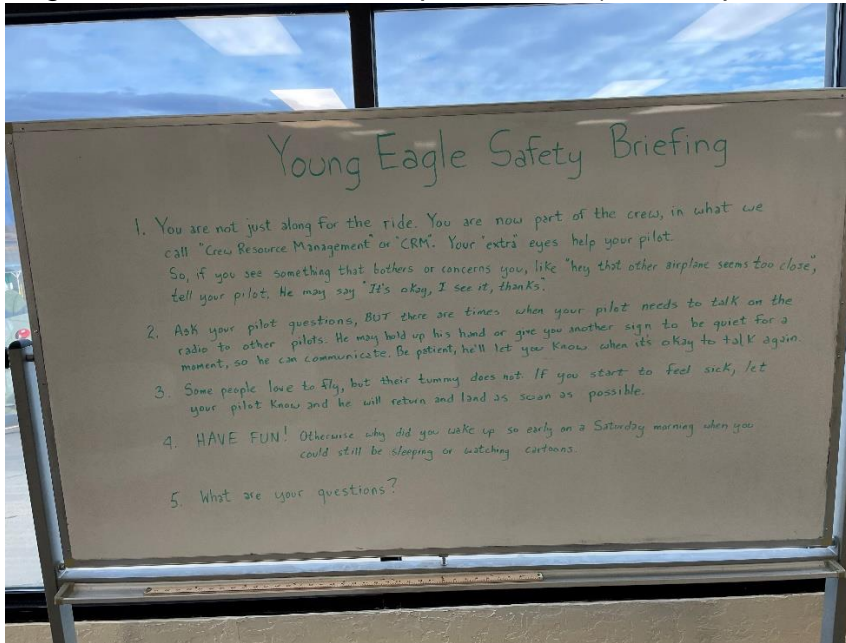
- The day started a bit chilly and cloudy, but the decision was made that the minimums were within safety limits, so first order of business was to hold the Pilot's Meeting:
