Similar to the Wright Brothers, the Longster went less than 120 feet flown at Kitty Hawk and the altitude was slightly less, but make no mistake about it, the Longster was aloft for the first time.

Attempts at guessing the Center of Gravity appeared to be successful as the aircraft was straight and level and, according to reports from the scene, came back to earth in a near perfect three point touchdown.

While there is still some work to be done, the first successful liftoff is most certainly newsworthy.


