September Chapter Gathering

The October Chapter Gathering is set for October 14 at 3:00 pm. The Board is pursuing various options for a presentation which will be announced along with the location in the October newsletter.

Board of Directors Meeting

The September Board of Directors meeting will be held September 27, 2023 at 5:00 pm. As with the Chapter Gathering, the location hasn't yet been determined and members will be notified by further communication.

Galesburg Airport Advisory Commission

The next Airport Advisory Commission is scheduled for September 21, 2023 at 3:00 pm in the Jet Air conference room.

Treasurer's Report

The Treasurer report included a Chapter financial statement through August 2023. The current balance of funds on hand is \$6,996.38. The Chapter annual report has been accepted by the Attorney General. The Attorney General also confirmed that there is no filing fee required from the Chapter with the annual report as the Chapter's finances are less than the statutory threshold requiring filing fees.

The Treasurer also reported the Chapter has accumulated \$240 in Young Eagles credits which can be used to acquire various EAA merchandise offered by the national EAA. These credits must be used by year end or they expire. The Board of Directors will be reviewing the use of these credits for merchandise supporting Chapter activities.

Upon motion duly made and seconded, the Treasurer's report was unanimously approved.

National Weather Service Presentation

Chuck Schaeffer from the Lincoln office of the National Weather Service made a presentation at the August Chapter Gathering. His presentation included information surrounding the current drought conditions, national weather service procedures surrounding radiosonde readings and the various weather forecasting tools available to pilots on the NWS website. He also offered that the NWS welcomes groups to observe an actual radiosonde launch at their facility and invited the Chapter to attend. These launches are made at 6:00 am and 6:00 pm. This may be an agenda item to pursue in the spring of 2024 since the harvest is upon us and daylight hours will be shortening rapidly in the next few weeks. Thank you to Chuck for his efforts!




9/1 WINGS (1927) starring Clara Bow & Buddy Rogers
