

Directions to Scharfenberg's - Google Maps are a wonderful thing, but not everybody has that capability or inclination so, here are directions: From Knoxville; take Broad Street/Knox Hwy 8 south 8 miles to the T intersection, turn left onto Knox Hwy 20, go 1 mile to the curve where you will see a large farm grain bin setup. Keep right at the curve and take the gravel lane past the grain bins ½ mile east to the house. From Abingdon, follow east Martin Street/Knox Hwy. 23 east about 7 ½ miles to the curve and the grain bins. Bear right and follow the gravel lane straight east ½ mile. From Maquon, follow Knox Hwy 20 west about 6 ½ miles where you will see the large grain set-up on your left. Turn left onto the road on the south side of the grain bins and follow the gravel lane straight east ½ mile.
