Just a reminder that May 22, 2021 will be our first official Young Eagles Rally! The event is tentatively planned to start at 9:00 am.We have opted to have a closed registration for this event with Girl Scout Troop 3019 which has around 12 girls in 6th-12th grade.

We currently have 2 confirmed planes and pilots for this event (and a couple "it depends on farming"), and two confirmed ground crew. Bill Hurley has also volunteered his Cardinal and himself for ground orientation/static display. We still need volunteers including a Young Eagles Coordinator. EAA National wants at

least two members to be present for each aspect of the outing. Each YE volunteer needs to complete the YE training and background check and have a certificate of completion in their immediate personal possession at all times during the event. The training only takes a couple minutes on line via the EAA website. So check your calendars and let me know if you would be able to help! Lunch will be provided to volunteers after the event!!

Finally, it was also mentioned at the Gathering that in order to hold youth events, we may have to get background checks done with the Galesburg Police Department. We followed up with our most recently retired Police Chief and determined that the City offers a service where you can get a background check done if an event requires it and that event does not offer the resources to get the background check. Since EAA requires and offers a background check for youth events, no additional background check by the City of Galesburg is needed.

B 17 VISIT Aaron Repp

All of the coordinator positions have been filled! I (Aaron Repp) will be the Tour Stop Chairman, Ellie Repp is the Volunteer and Equipment Coordinator, and Nate Compton & Ellen Larson have stepped up to be Co-Marketing Chairpersons.

One of the major updates this month is that the proposed schedule for the B-17 arrival might change. At this time, EAA is attempting to add an additional stop prior to coming to KGBG, this could push the arrival to September 8th or 9th instead of the 6th. Due to COVID19, EAA has also put a stop to the B-17 ground tours, but are hopeful that by the time September rolls around ground tours may be able to take place again.

Another change from the last Gathering is the location and set-up on the ramp. The B-17 has been pushed to the far south side where we will most likely have dedicated parking spots for flying passengers and have the space the aircraft needs. Self-serve would be closed for this layout.

We are still waiting on a response from EAA about the insurance requirements and stipulations, but we (and our EAA contact) are not concerned. It was basically stated that they have dozens of stops coming up before September and they just haven't had time to get to our concerns. In the meantime, I'll be attending monthly meetings with the City, Jet Air, and Stearman to coordinate and continue making progress on this exciting event!
