#### Airport News

- DME work will be complete in a couple of weeks
- Wind sensor—a bird purportedly ate the last wind sensor even though it was armed with metal spikes and was installed 25 ft above ground.
- Work will begin on the new runway 3-21 in May of 2024, dependent on weather, contracted for about 80 days. The first project is the intersection of the runways, which should take about 30 days. At that time the only active runway will be 03. Upon completion of the intersection, runways 14-32 will be available for the duration of the project.
