#### **B-25 Miss Mitchell**

The B-25 Miss Mitchell is scheduled for Saturday and Sunday, August 2 and 3. Chapter members interested in a ride might be wise to sign up relatively soon. After alerting Freedom for Patriots about the event, they expressed the intention to purchase twelve to eighteen rides. Sounds like we will meet the minimum of 24 and the chapter won't have to pay for the crew's lodging.

#### Airport Day 2025

During the chapter meeting we had a lively discussion with innovative ideas for the event. The local group Freedom for Patriots has shown interest in a presence at the event. As noted above they are buying B-25 tickets. They suggested renaming it "Freedom of Flight". Comments were that it needed a link to the Menominee airport and that it should express a welcome to the general public.

A car show was discussed. Steve suggested targeting a younger crowd, people who are outfitting later model cars, not the antique ones. However, having cars competing with huge sound systems was deemed not a good idea. Rick mentioned our event at the last car club meeting and got a positive response. He cautioned that exhibitors sometimes sign up and don't show. The possibility of a car show of specific models was suggested by Delores and Mark, who had contacted clubs. The car show wouldn't have competition and prizes. It is important to get the date and program on calendars as soon as possible. We could have flyers distributed at car shows in June to early August.

A bike rally was discussed. Jeff suggested a "show and shine" for kids with bikes. It could be a safety seminar. Sometimes police will give out helmets to kids who don't have them. "Finger print your kids" was also discussed as an event, coordinated with another group to keep the records.

Jeremy had inquired from the Coast Guard about the possibility of a helicopter and a C-130.

Freedom for Patriots had some great suggestions. Start the event with a color guard and band at 8 am. Then the first flight of six of veterans would have their B-25 ride. Successive rides would be open to all. Mark suggested the Marinette HS choral group that could sing all the service branch songs.

Pat suggested that we rent a large tent if we expect a big crowd. Steve suggested getting sponsors for place mats. Mare Hare marketing of Marinette could help. We discussed the need for more food trucks. We have to make sure they are compatible and their choices don't overlap too much. Suggestions were Tasty Traveler and Layers of Flavor.

It was suggested the Young Eagles event focus on the children of first responders or veterans.

Our last big event for this year is a repeat of Santa's visit to Menominee Airport. We have secured Santa for the day. At the November meeting we will have a sign-up list for volunteers. See last month's newsletter for details.
