AirVenture Cup Race Takes Place Sunday, July 21

"The AirVenture Cup Cross-Country Air Race (AVC) is the world's premier amateur open-circuit air race open to all experimental and factory-built aircraft," according to their website, www.airventurecuprace.com. This annual event is a part of next week's AirVenture celebration in Oshkosh. Competitors fly a wide variety of aircraft over the course depicted on the map. Almost one hundred planes have registered with the top speed of 400 and the slowest speed of 100, starting at 9AM from Wausau Downtown. KMNM is an intermediate checkpoint of the course. You might be interested in watching all the racers overfly our airport at midmorning the Sunday.

Progress has been made in submitting an application to the state to have the 5K event on our runways. The new target month is October.

By next Wednesday or Thursday, July 24 or 25, the airport should be fully open again. However, the reconstructed runway will close for about a week in August to groove and apply more paint.

The ILS on Rwy 3 will continue to be out of service until the antenna is completely fixed and the FAA can flight check all the changes.

Pilots are advised to always check the NOTAMS immediately before flying as they may change. Also, listen on the CTAF for any vehicular traffic on runways or taxiways.
