Van's Aircraft Update:

- The bankruptcy judge approved Van's reorganization plan.
- The VanGrunsven trust converts \$7M of loans into an equity stake in Van's Aircraft.
- 83% of buyers were reported to have signed off on the price hikes.
- The balance of buyers will receive 100% on their 1st \$3K, and any balance of deposits at 50¢ on the dollar.
- Parts are shipping if they are in stock.
- Van's is able to supply full kits.
