- Doug Vogel passed around a block of LL-900 Space Shuttle tile material.
 This material was used on over 20,000 tiles on the outside of the 5 shuttle orbiters.
 - A question was asked on the cost of a shuttle tile. While exact estimates are approximations, multiple web sources indicate each tile ran about \$1,000.

- Jeff King shared his home made ADS-B Ground Receiver, allowing one to capture and, with the help of https://www.adsbexchange.com/ways-to-join-the-exchange/, view aircraft tracking data.
 - The device uses a Raspberry Pi processor
 - MicroSD card
 - Antenna
 - Assorted electronic components https://www.adsbexchange.com/hardware/
 - Line of sight (LOS) operation from your antenna
 - Does not feed data to the federal ATC system
- Ralph Capen shared an interesting headset plug configuration he calls 'Building to an Interface." He uses a standard molex connector with multiple, individual electrically isolated plugs to allow ease of use when switching headsets.
