New Richmond Regional Airport (NRRA) Announcements

NRRA's South End paving project has been put off till next spring due to funding issues.

Unlighted but reflective taxiway guidance signs have been installed on all NRRA main taxiways. These signs will be replaced with lighted signs during thec2026/7 Taxiway Alpha Reconstruction project.

The airport is undergoing the creation of a master plan that will guide the development of the airport for the next 20 years. A key component of the plan is the ability to get city water to multiple sites at NRRA. City personnel are working to address this need.

NRRA Gates - Gate 1 closes at 10 pm and reopens at 4:30 am during the week, and 6 am on the weekends. This keypad works. Gate 2 will remain open 24/7. Gate 3 closes at 10 pm, reopens at 4:30 am during the week and 6 am on the weekends. The keypad does not work. After 10 pm, you can only exit through this gate. To re-enter, use Gate 2. Be mindful of ramp traffic! Funding for new gates is pending.
