Board Meeting Minutes 8/30/2022

Our board meetings are open to all interested members. These meetings are for planning chapter events and discussing the business side of running the chapter.

There were eight officers and members who attended the meeting either in-person or online. We covered the following topics:

- Planning for the Wrens Fly-In event in October. Saturday, October 1st is the main event (10 am to 5 pm) where many rotorcraft, ultralights and larger fixed wing aircraft will be on display, plus we will be giving Young Eagles flights. We will need help with setup on Friday, September 30th and takedown on Sunday, October 2nd, plus volunteers on Saturday to marshal aircraft and share info about our chapter.
- 2. The annual Board officer elections are at our November meeting. Terry Stout will be collecting nominations for the four officers (President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer) and other roles to be filled. We decided to seek a Young Eagles Coordinator, a Youth Activities Director, Social Media Coordinator, and a Food Director.
- 3. Our Pea Patch Clubhouse is in dire need of maintenance to the HVAC system, leaky roof and pest control. We discussed a low-cost option for HVAC. Nandi and Terry volunteered to check out the roof issue. Nandi will order termite treatment to be applied later this fall.
- 4. We discussed meeting plans for the remainder of 2022. The board voted to skip the October meeting due to the Wrens Fly-In. Sandy will propose the 2023 calendar of meetings and events at the next board meeting.
- 5. Sandy gave a financial update and membership update. We voted to keep the dues at \$30 for next year.

WHERE TO FIND US:
