

# Maintenance Corner

## **Scribing a Straight Line on Tubing**

You have a template to mark it, a jig to drill it, and a third hand to hold it. Now, how do you make those 90-degree or 180-degree points down the tube? If you have a steady hand and hold your mouth just right, you can do it.

Take a piece of tube the same size or slightly smaller than the one you wish to mark. Lay them together on a smooth surface with the mark you wish to move, about 30-45 degrees up from where they touch. Holding your marking pen or awl, rest your hand on the table and the second tube. Move your hand down the tube to transfer the mark. Use the same method for two bolt holes.

Also, reminder you if you completed the EAA Youth Protection Program for Young Eagles to please check your renewal date as we hope to have another good Young Eagles year this year.


