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# EAA Chapter 211 Meeting Minutes – 2016-01-08

#### Attendance: 29

#### Call to order and Pledge of Allegiance – 19:30

The Jan. 8 Chapter 211 meeting was called to order by President Dan Whisman.

#### **Attendance and Visitors:**

A total of 29 people (26 members and 3 visitors) were in attendance at the January meeting. The welcomed visitors included Dick Foster from EAA 145, Ethan Beswick from Holland (working on RV-7 project), and Phil Odan (friend of Cliff Cole).

#### **Event and Meeting Dates:**

#### **Previous Meeting Minutes:**

A motion was made, seconded and unanimously passed to accept the December 4, 2015 meeting minutes.

#### Treasure's Report and the Past Month's Expenses and Receipts:

We had receipts/donations, not including next years dues, of \$17.50 and expenses of \$646.04, including \$490.00 for next years EAA Dues and Insurance. The expenses include \$29.35 of supplies and newsletter costs and \$126.69 from the Christmas Dinner & Awards Banquet. We deposited \$430.00 in dues and petty cash funds into the checking account. The checkbook balance is \$3255.12. Petty cash balance is \$33.50. This gives us a total Chapter 211 current meeting fund balance of \$3,288.62. The budget figure would be about \$2,870.00. As a note, the annual EAA Chapter dues and insurance expense was \$40.00 more dollars than our figure included in the 2015 budget. Last year at this time we had a fund balance of \$3294.63, but that did not include any 2015 dues.

#### 2015 Budget and End of Year Report:

Expenses: Projected \$1,593.00; Actual \$1,788.87 Receipts: Projected \$1,477.00; Actual \$1,250.75

Motion was made, seconded and and unanimously passed to accept the treasure's report.

#### **Chapter Membership and Dues:**

We ended 2015 with 49 members (48 paid members). We currently have 19 paid 2016 members. It was explained that, on the envelopes provided, simply print (CLEARLY) your name and EAA membership number, and any new or changed contact information, then insert \$22 (or \$25 if member wants newsletter mailed) cash or check for your 2016 dues.
