Enjoying the warm weather.

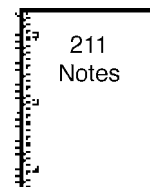
There was no Saturday Eaglet work day in May so I do not have an update on the project.

Chet passed some photos for a project report.

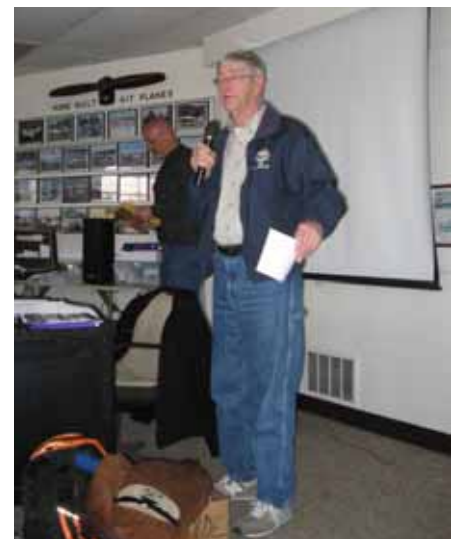
Karl passed around a sign up sheet for Young Eagles volunteers.

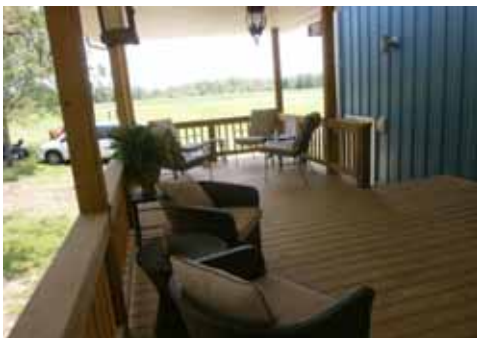
