EAA Chapter 211 December 5 Meeting Minutes

December 5 minutes

President Bob called the meeting to order with the pledge of allegiance. There were 20 members and one visitor in attendance. The minutes of the November meeting were approved. The treasure's report was given and approved.

The Jack Elenbaas memorial was discussed. We also, discussed the Herb Kelly memorial gifts. Scott DeGaynor provided much information as to what items were sold and that Gary VanFarrow had stored the majority of the items.

Bill Scheltema asked if we noticed that the room was a little warmer that last month. The natural gas had been shut off by the airport management. Bill and Paul Overbeek converted the furnace to propane and all was working correctly. The propane has a lock so that we can control when it gets used. The cost of conversion and gas supply came to \$352.88.

There was discussion about your license stating English proficient on the back if you were or even remotely might fly international. There is a \$3.00 charge to change a plastic license to read English proficient. It was also noted that the paper license would be obsolete and expire in March of 2010. There is no charge to replace the paper license. You can get all the information at <u>www.faa.gov</u>

Bill Scheltema offered to be custodian of the projector, DVD

player, and scales. The group was in agreement.

Flight advisor Ken Dannenberg reported there were a total of 180 accidents in November. Of these 23 were fatal with a total of 34 fatalities. Out of these there were 27 experimental accidents with 8 fatal and 12 fatalities. Some of the planes mentioned were: Legend, Sonex, Skybolt II, Hornet II, Mustang, Zodiac 601. Also noted was a Beechcraft that landed in fog at Memphis on 18 C rather than on 18 L and some problems with a Pawnee and glider trying to occupy the same airspace.

The Zenith 601, 650 light sport aircraft known as the Zodiac are all grounded till up grades are made to the spars, ailerons are balance and bell cranks. Those that are licensed as experimental have a strong recommendation to make the same upgrades. Those that have crashed are thought to have developed flutter. Flutter has been reported as a major cause of rekiting as aircraft.

Jack B. said the Tech report was very slow and not much going on.

Next years board members are Pete Mulliner, Stan Briggs, and Jack Brewer. This was made official by a motion from Scott D. and second by John G. with a resounding approval of those present. Stan noted that he had been in industry for several years and was now teaching CAD and materials at MCC.

There was a quarry if EAA knew that Jack Elenbaas had gone west and if they would be including him in the column by that name in Sport Aviation.

Coffee was followed by a DVD "Last Flight Home," very interesting as many of us had friends and relatives in WWII.
