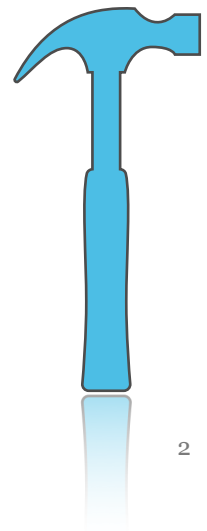

 - *Ray Aviation Scholarship application due end of January, someone besides Ron needs to apply for the funds. \$10,000 grant to further aviation in a certain timeframe of milestones for qualified candidate. David will get login information over to Ron/Rex this week to access site
 - *College Place is doing YE workshop Jan 28 which gives them credit for club recognition. We should help out to see if it is something we want to do in the future. Helpers must have youth protection up to date in order to volunteer. More discussion at general meeting

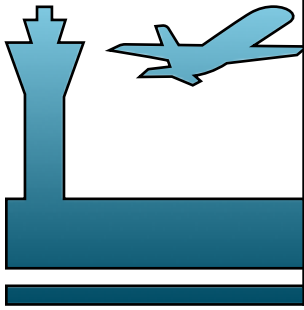
