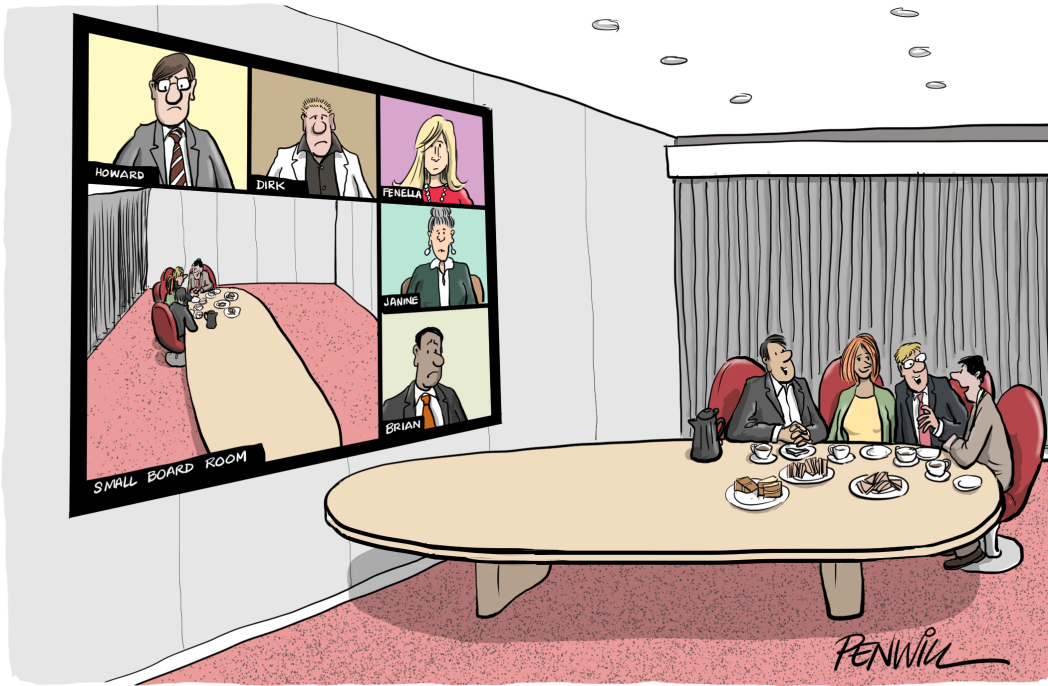
Destinations are Tentatively LaGrande, Pendleton, Martin Field, Hermiston, and Lewiston.

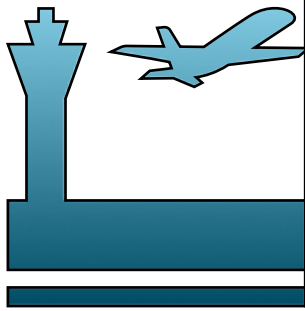
