WHAT'S HAPPENING?


Runway 17/35, the Airport's air carrier runway, was last rehabilitated in **1998**.

As current pavement approaches its end of life, the Airport has planned to rehabilitate the runway in **June of 2019**.

During much of this project, the Airport will be closed to commercial/airline traffic.



Non-instrument rated pilots who want to improve their proficiency now have an excellent new resource through EAA's VMC Club.

The Build



4493E, a 1948 Aeronca Champ was purchased out of New York in early June. It is an 85 hp version, known as a 7DC, as opposed to the popular 65 hp 7AC model.

In the last month the fuselage was painted Glacier White, and the wings were inspected. Although one main wing spar was properly repaired in the distant past by a prior owner, it will be replaced in order to meet the quality level for this rebuild. Members involved in this project are pursuing the legendary (at least to them) "Purple Lindy", so you see, the standard of workmanship here is exceptionally high. You understand, of course. (5)

The engine is being rebuilt in Wisconsin and should soon be ready for pick up. In the next month, the control cables and bushings are being replaced. Stay tuned. \bigstar
