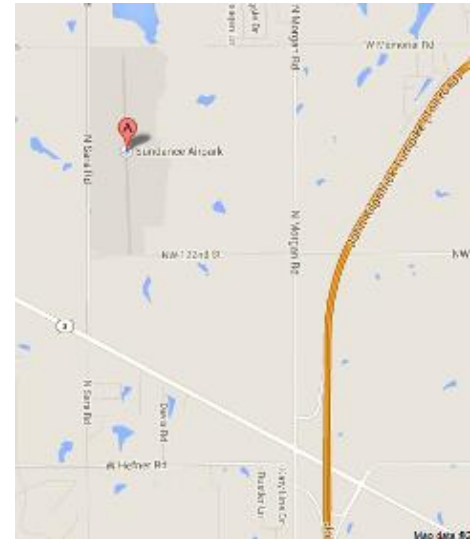

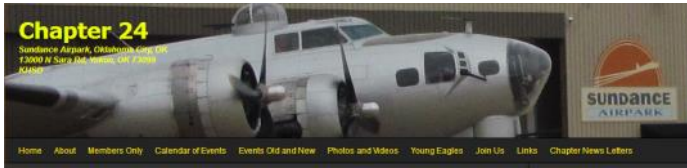

Pilots Needed

The FAA Civil Aerospace Medical Institute is currently conducting a Pilot Reports (PIREPs) proof-of-concept research study exploring the concepts of submitting and retrieving Pilot Reports (PIREPs) over VHF radio:

- On a dedicated frequency (122.0MHz), and
- Without having to talk to an ATC controller or Flight Service specialist.

The effort could pave the way toward an additional means to submit and retrieve PIREPs.

For the period of time between **November 4, 2022** and **April 30, 2023**; the FAA is looking for pilots who are flying within or overflying (e.g., in the flight levels) the areas with radius of ~ 50 nm from two airports:

Will Rogers World Airport (KOKC) in Oklahoma, and

Nenana Municipal Airport (PANN) in Alaska.

Volunteers are needed. Participation will be compensated.

The study is conducted on the FAA CAMI's Cloud-based Aviation Weather Human Factors Research Platform (CbTOPS) that is available as a web and a mobile application. Pilots who are willing to volunteer with this study may go to <https://cbtopsatacami.faa.gov/> or may use the QR code below:



EAA Announces Inaugural Learn to Fly Week – May 15 to 20



Aspiring aviators will have the opportunity to discover multiple pathways to becoming a pilot as EAA presents its inaugural *Learn to Fly Week* on *May 15-20*.

paring for the FAA written exam, to passing the checkride, and so much more. While the live showing of these presentations will be open to the public, the recordings will be archived for EAA members to view at their convenience.

Learn to Fly Week will conclude on *Saturday, May 20*, with Flying Start events hosted at chapters across the country. EAA's Flying Start program allows EAA chapters to welcome, encourage, and educate new aviation enthusiasts about the fun, freedom, and accessibility of personal aviation in their local area.

Following a short presentation about learning to fly, attendees will be offered a free introductory Eagle Flight to experience the spirit of aviation firsthand.

"Becoming a pilot is a dream for many, but few know where to start their journey. Learn to Fly Week was created to help encourage aspiring pilots to take action and begin the pilot training process," said David Leiting, EAA Eagles Program Manager. "Our goal is to show attendees how accessible achieving their dream actually is." Leiting also added that inspiration from this event stemmed from packed forums at the Learn to Fly Center at EAA AirVenture Oshkosh 2022, as well as the success of other EAA virtual events like Homebuilders Week and Virtual Ultralight Days.

Combining the educational forums from the Learn to Fly Center and the connections and inspiration found at Flying Start events, EAA Learn to Fly Week is the latest effort in the ongoing effort to help aspiring pilots achieve their dream of flight.

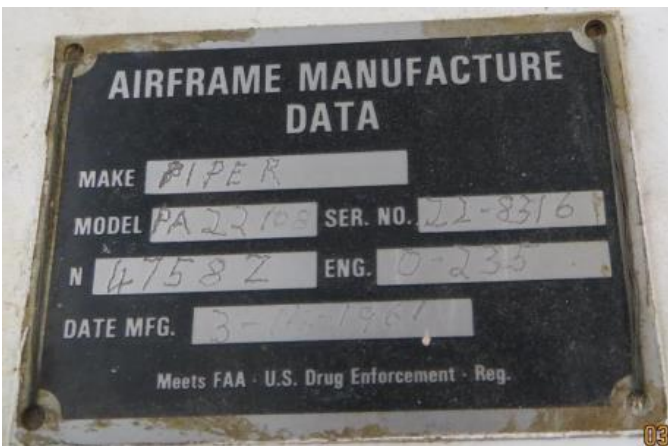

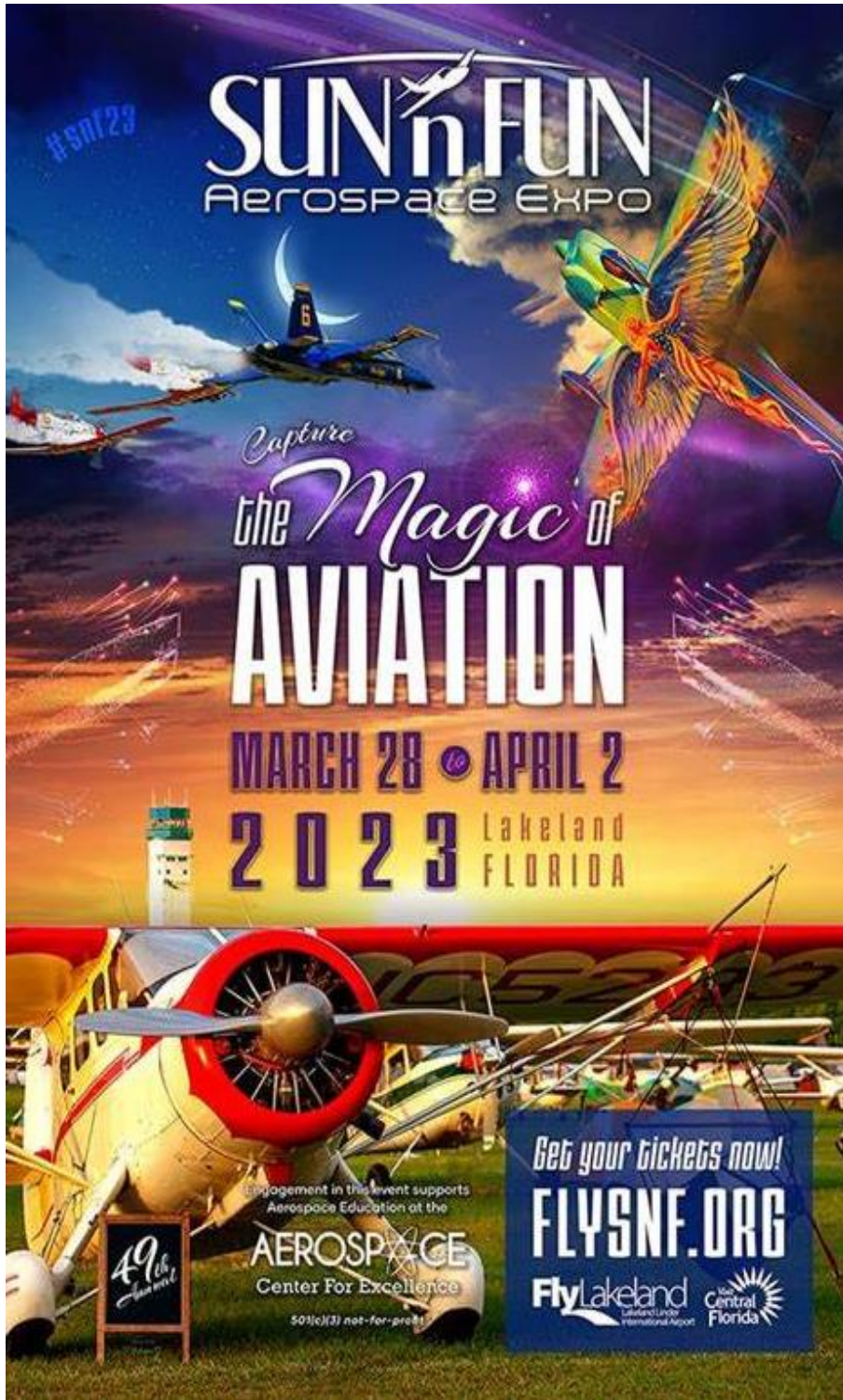

QUESTION OF THE WEEK Special VFR (SVFR) clearance

VMC Question:

“What is a Special VFR (SVFR) clearance, and under what conditions can a pilot get one?”



Normally, if a pilot is flying under visual flight rules, the pilot must continue to abide by the VFR rules throughout the duration of the flight. When making an approach to landing, if conditions are such that the airport is designated instrument flight rules only, in theory the VFR pilot must divert to an alternate location that is accepting VFR traffic. The same applies to taking off. If conditions at the originating airport do not meet VFR minimums of 3 statute miles (SM) visibility or 1,000' cloud separation, as a rule VFR pilots will be unable to takeoff since the airport is under IFR.

Exceptions can be made, however, under the right circumstances, and this is where Special VFR (SVFR) clearances come into play.

A Special VFR clearance is an **authorization that VFR pilots can request**, and which may be issued at air traffic control (ATC)'s discretion. The clearance allows a VFR pilot to takeoff or land from an [IFR](#) airport under Special Visual Flight Rules providing they meet the Special VFR clearance restrictions.

Most of the time if an airfield is operating under IFR, it makes sense for VFR pilots to divert if they are in the air or remain on the ground if they are waiting to take off. A SVFR clearance does not allow you to enter clouds. The scenarios where requesting a Special VFR clearance makes

sense are when you have excellent weather surrounding or near the airport in your direction of travel. If it is just the immediate area which is below minimums, and you are still safely able to navigate visually until you land or until you reach the surrounding VFR airspace on takeoff, a Special VFR clearance might make sense. The FAA allows special VFR clearance to be issued for terminal areas in Class B, Class C, Class D, and Class E airspace, although some Class B and Class C airports do not issue them. [FAR Part 91.151](#), [Part 91 Appendix D Section 3](#) contains a list of airports which do not authorize Special VFR clearances. Aeronautical publications for these airports will also indicate “NO SVFR.” The requirements aircraft must meet to be eligible to receive a SVFR clearance are detailed under [FAR Part 91.157](#), and depend on whether you are flying fixed wing or rotary wing as well as whether it is day or night. Fixed wing aircraft flying during the day must meet the following requirements:

- Be operating under Part 91
- Receive ATC clearance before entering the designated IFR airspace
- Remain clear of clouds
- Have at least 1 statute mile (SM) of ground visibility reported at the airport the pilot is requesting to land or depart from or 1 statute mile (SM) of flight visibility at an airport with no weather reporting capability. Between sunset and sunrise, fixed wing aircraft must meet day requirements along with the following additional requirements:

- Pilot must be instrument rated

Aircraft must be equipped for IFR night flight per [FAR Part 91.205\(d\)](#)

Rotary wing pilots must meet fewer requirements than their fixed wing counterparts in order to qualify for a Special VFR clearance. Rotary wing pilots do not need to be IFR certified to request night SVFR clearance, and they are also not constrained by the 1 statute mile visibility requirements. Rotary pilots must simply:

- Receive ATC clearance before entering the designated IFR airspace
- Remain clear of clouds
