The June 11th **Young Eagles day** was a great success, with over 45 young eagles receiving flights on a one on one basis, with the odd parent thrown in when the aircraft was capable. The weather gods smiled on us and our young eagles to make the flights not only memorable, but enjoyable as well. **Thanks to all** the dedicated volunteers, both on the ground and in the air, and **especially Lars Eif** for a top notch professional show.

The Canada Day air display July 1st at the National Aviation Museum, RockCliffe was also a success with four aircraft on display and three participating in the fly-bys. Rod Emmerson's Teenie Two was a dazzling static display as Rod still had some fine tuning to do on his carburetor; so he had to watch as the rest of us indulged our fighter pilot fantasies for the fly-by. Thanks to Keith Davidson in his CH-601, and Luc Desadeleer in his RV-6 for joining in the show.

The Air Adventure Day, run in conjunction with the NAM, and scheduled for July 9th at RockCliffe was unfortunately cancelled due to too small a sign up, only four registrants. Hopefully next year will see a return to the 1993 registration levels.

We have one more major chapter sponsored events remaining this year that is going to need your support. The annual chapter **flyin breakfast on Sunday August 14th** with setup and general cleanup the day before, Saturday morning. Barney deSchneider is the contact for this important annual event. Barney assures me it will be even bigger than past years, and I know we can count on your support.

On Sunday June 25th, I was a static display participant at the Trenton Airshow. Originally Luc Desadeleer and I were to arrive on Friday evening, with some flying displays planned; however the CB & IFR gods had something to say about that on Friday & Saturday. Sunday's journey started out marginal VFR with low ceilings (1000 - 1400 ft.); and I was greeted with a robust 20 knot gusts to 30 knots wind on landing on runway 24 at Trenton.

Thankfully it was from 230 and simply allowed me to practice three landings in one approach.


The show at Trenton is top notch; however I got to see little as I was generally mobbed by the curious public either asking weird questions, or in the occasional case trying to twist and wiggle various parts of the aircraft. Not only does the Lancair fly like a mini fighter, it also obviously looks the part, at least in the minds of some of the younger generation.

One keen observer in a flight suit asked all kinds of questions regarding the aerobatic capabilities of the aircraft. Only after much discussion, did he reveal that he was a Snowbird pilot, and would do almost anything for a ride in a Lancair. Anything that is except swap a ride in a red and white Tutor. Oh well at least I can dream.

It was encouraging to see the amount of interest shown by people from all walks of life in our home built aircraft; it bodes well for the future.
