CTAF: 122.9

Ground/Parking: 122.725 for ground marshaller's

Private airport and land, obstacle and ground areas are not maintained to Public Airport Standards Pilot-controlled runway lighting: 122.8 (5 clicks)

Weather: https://tempestwx.com/station/20708/ Or KLAF or KFKR ATIS/AWOS.

Fuel: No Fuel at 31IN. Nearest AVGAS is KFKR and KLAF. If you end up too low to get somewhere please let us know and we can figure something out.

Runway 09-27: 3000 ft x 100 ft grass runway. Left Traffic.

09: Trees up to the approach threshold of the runway.

27: Trees with a notch followed by crop, private road, and then the threshold.

Cars give right-of-way but might not see landing traffic, please be mindful of cars driving in front of the runway threshold that may not be visible from the crop.

After Landing please exit the runway and taxi on the road and look for the runway lights.

Marshalling: There will be an air boss on 122.9 and airplane marshallers on 122.725. Expect to park on the West side of the house. If necessary or you are concerned to taxi on grass, we will have you shut down and push you to a spot. There will be kids running around and people not familiar with airplanes, so please be ready to stop and/or shut down your plane quickly if safety requires it. This is a family and friend gathering, so we shouldn't have anyone being disrespectful.

Amenities: A&P's. We have jump starters, air compressors, and all sorts of tools if you are in need. We also have some oil. We will take care of you if you get stranded. We are limited on chocks and tie downs, so bring your own if you want them.

Timberhouse Aero Estates Airstrip Briefing

Timberhouse is a private airstrip in Lafayette, IN. *Permission is required prior to landing*. Please read the information below and follow the recommendations when utilizing the airstrip. Use airstrip at your own risk.

31IN 40.2850364,-86.8563958 Elev: 726 ft. Runways (turf): 09/27 Pattern Altitude: 1726 ft.

Runway

- o 3000 ft. by 100 ft. CTAF 122.9
- Trees located at both ends of the runway that create obstacle on short final (at threshold of runway 27, and 800 ft. from 09)
- o Deer frequently cross runway, especially at dusk, use caution
- Use extreme caution landing at night
- Windsock located north of runway near midway point
- o Runway lights located every 200 ft. along runway with red lights and strobes at each end

Arrivals/Departures (based on Aircraft Circular AC 90-66C)

- Announce all intentions on 122.9 and watch for traffic (not all airplanes have radios/ADS-B)
- Left Hand Traffic Pattern (Minimize flying over homes to reduce noise for neighbors)
- Straight-in landings not recommended. Airstrip is active with airplanes that do not have radios or ADS-B, mowing equipment, radio-controlled aircraft, wildlife, ultralights, etc. and entering the downwind at a 45-degree angle allows pilots to view the windsock and look for activity on the runway, and allows those on the ground to clear the runway for your arrival
- Be aware and watch for aircraft as there is an aerobatics box located 1 mile South of airstrip
- Short approaches, low approaches, and overhead approaches should follow the guidelines in AC 90-66C.
- When departing, use the entire runway.
- Runway 09, especially around sunset, use caution aircraft are very hard to see holding short
 for take off and final due to trees blocking and creating a shadow. Do not recommend taking
 off with a tailwind around sunset, especially on 27 because pilots are unable to see departing
 traffic for 09.

Other

- Runway lights can be activated with 5 clicks on 122.80
- The paved road adjacent to the runway can be used for taxiing. Be aware of the runway lights when entering or departing the taxiway to/from the runway
- When parking your aircraft (host will assist with this) please make sure it far enough off the taxiway/road for other aircraft to safely pass (At least 25 feet from road). And do not shut down aircraft on the runway.
