Tim and I have rough cut a second Pedal Plane project. It took us roughly 2 hours. Now it needs to be trimmed to the finished dimensions on a router table. We would need a warm place to set up the router table and do the final trimming. I would anticipate that this might take another 2 hours.

Spaghetti dinner.

We approved a committee to plan this project. We need to actually form the committee, select a date, do the logistics and plan for additional activates. We do our pancake breakfast in conjunction with our Fly In and the Stewart's Open House.

I would suggest that we do the spaghetti dinner on Saturday, May 21, 2022. This is EAA's Learn to Fly day. We might try Young Eagles flights in the morning. Perhaps the Stewarts will be willing to provide introductory flights in the afternoon. Maybe they would also offer flights in their Stearman. The goal would be to get a bit of publicity and activity at the airport. The dinner would then be in the late afternoon.

Meeting was called to order at 2:30pm

Old Business:

- Blossom shared information about the Facebook page and Mailchimp
- Bob talked about Spaghetti Dinner options for mid-May.
 Dewey Davenport & Stewarts suggested as possible people to offer plane rides during the time.
 - Mike moved to assign a sub-committee for the food aspect; Tim seconded.
 - Bob will send his notes on this to Blossom for when a sub-committee is arranged (there were no volunteers at the meeting).
- Mike updated on the Pedal Planes Kit that was ordered per our last meeting. Currently EAA284 is 50th in line; we were given a \$25 discount; it includes all parts and pieces needed for the build; total before shipping is \$383. When kit arrives, Mike will coordinate with others.
- Bob shared what he has been doing in regard to the plans he'd purchased previously; had pieces laser cut and we can use for templates on future builds. Also shared some of his graphics for the pedal plane.

Treasurer/Financial: No report.

New Business:

- Mike shared about Chapter camping at EAA Oshkosh AirVenture (more details will be available in March)-
 - \$252/site/week; minimum of 2 sites, maximum of 10; benefits:
 - · very close to the entrance gate
 - can arrive as early as July 15, stay until July 31 (and still only pay \$252)
