The Regulatory Minute

14 CFR 91.111 pertains to operating near other aircraft

- a) No person may operate an aircraft so close to another aircraft as to create a collision hazard.
- b) No person may operate an aircraft in formation flight except by arrangement with the pilot in command of each aircraft of the formation.
- c) No person may operate an aircraft carrying passengers for hire, in formation flight.
