AOPA Air Safety Institute Seminar Tuesday Sept 23, 2014



The Regulatory Minute

14CFR91.3 is your sword and your shield: "The pilot in command of an aircraft is directly responsible for, and is the final authority as to, the operation of that aircraft." Don't give up your authority to any controller nor other authority if it puts your life or the life of others in danger. The PIC calls the final shot, and remember that in an emergency. (Be aware, you may have to answer to the Administrator if so requested within 10 days.) You can always deal with paperwork later.
