From The Desk of the President



Greetings and salutations, EAA Chapter 327 members! Here we are in July, half way through the year. There is lots of activity going on around the Chapter, as usual.

Our members have been busy. There was a Dubuque Airport Open House last month the weekend of the 4th of

July, attended by about 2,000, and we had a few tables set up to talk with people about EAA. We were in sight of the Vans RV formation flying team from Falcon Field near Atlanta. What beautiful airplanes! Most of the pilots built their own planes and were standing by to answer any questions from the crowd. Joan Knockel and Lyle Hefel were at the EAA tables with me. We had the RV-12 and RV-10 on display and CAP had a Cessna 182.

Our military services were represented with two A-10 Thunderbolts and a CH-47 Chinook helicopter along with the Golden Knights. The Haubenstricker family manned the Civil Air Patrol recruiting table. Bridger and Ed were working for the airport helping manage the many attendees. Bridger took photos of the event, he says about 1,000! Joan signed up 30 Young Eagles on a waiting list for the next event, so pilots with access to an airplane, please register as a Young Eagle Pilot if you can give these kids an airplane ride. You get additional liability insurance from EAA for doing so. We can use some help.

This month our airport will host the NATA group, North American Trainers Association. We expect about 60 aircraft, with many T-6's, but some T-28's and P-51's who come to practice formation flying before Osh-

Project progress last month includes getting the aileron rigging routed on Bob Rogers & Merle Neises Cessna 150. Nick Hirsch has been offering A&P and IA help and Art Olechowski recently called in some help from contacts at Textron Aviation.

The RV-12 is has been to Leading Edge Airfoils in Burlington, WI to have the gearbox reduction unit resealed with the assistance of Doug Brotherton and Mark Wallace providing transportation. The RV-12 has 16 hours on the engine and airframe now. Don Hedeman is working on the gear of his Tailwind Project. Mark Wallace on the panel and engine instruments on his Zenith 650 project, Art Olechowski &Dusty Bodine are working on Zenith 750 projects. We should have several of these projects become airplanes in the years to come.

The radio-controlled youth build & fly project has finished the wing frame and started on the fuselage with modifications being done to accommodate an electric engine. Thank you to all who participate and the mentors who provide guidance.

Our Chapter will be meeting next Tuesday with dinner at 6:30, meeting at 7 in EAA Hanger 88. Art Oleshowski will be providing a light meal. Programming will include discussion of Chapter camping at Oshkosh, EAA Chapter video and an aviation themed video. Saturday morning coffee continues to be well attended and the simulator is getting lots of use. Please come. The more the merrier.

Here is a way to avoid congestion at the departure end of the runway. With Dubuque airport having over 80,000 operations a year, we have become the busiest airport in Iowa, largely due to the busy Flight Department at the University of Dubuque training pilots.
