

2025 Air Academy Application

EAA Chapter 35 will award one position in the EAA's 2025 Explore Camp, held at their headquarters campus in Oshkosh, Wisconsin, July 15-23. In addition to a position in the one week camp, **the chapter scholarship fund will pay the tuition and transportation.**

Approximately 50 youth attend each camp session. Activities are based on a science, technology, engineering, and mathematics exploration of various aviation activities and are specifically designed to encourage enthusiasm for aviation in 16 to 18 year olds.

All young men and women with a passion for aviation are encouraged to apply.

Applicants must be:

- At least 16 years old on July 15, 2025, but not older than 18 years old on July 23, 2025
- Attending school or an accredited Home Study program
- Have their parent's or legal guardian's permission to apply for and attend the camp
- Able to travel alone on a scheduled airline from San Antonio to Oshkosh, Wisconsin, and return. However, applicants with physical or mental disabilities are welcome to apply if their parents/guardians make all necessary special arrangements for the participation of their youth

Applicants must submit an essay (max 800 words), an audio file (max 8 minutes), or a video file (max 8 minutes) explaining:

- why you are our ideal scholarship recipient
- what interests you in aviation
- what aviation experiences you may have had and
- what activities outside of school are currently involved, or have been involved
