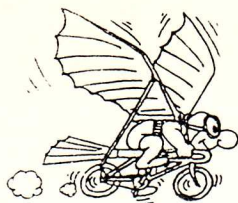

KERRVILLE '82 FLY-IN

The following basic information is provided for your use in planning and making arrangements to attend the KERRVILLE '82 FLY-IN.

Dates: September 17, 18, & 19th.

Place: Kerrville, Texas --- Louis Schreiner Field

Airport Information:

Runways 2 & 20 will be CLOSED

Runways 12 & 30 will be the ACTIVE

FIELD CLOSED-- Sept. 18 ( 1:00 P.M.- 3:00 P.M.)

Sept. 19 ( 1:00 P.M.- 2:00 P.M.)

NOTE: There will be NO FAA control tower. For all approaching aircraft use RIGHT TRAFFIC for runway 12; use LEFT TRAFFIC for runway 30. There will be NO FLY-BYS allowed on INITIAL APPROACH. Fly-bys will only be permitted after your landing and attending a BRIEFING on the FLY-BY PATTERN.

CAUTION: UNICOM ( 122.8 ) will be very congested- SO- Listen up; Look up; SEE and BE SEEN; FOLLOW TRAFFIC; Space yourself accordingly. Once on the ground exit the runway as soon as practical; signs and ground handlers will direct you to the proper parking area.

TIE-DOWNS: Are required. Suggest you bring your own, however, there will be a limited number available at registration for \$10.00 with a \$5.00 refund upon return.

FUEL:----- Dugosh Flying Service Ph.512-896-8441 80/100/Jet.  
80/100 will be in the trucks and at pumps south end of field.

REGISTRATION: A \$5.00 registration fee applies to the following:

- A. EAA Members ( Includes Spouse, Children under 18)
- B. FLY in Pilots.
- C. Guests of A or B who want on the flight line.

CAMPING: Aircraft camping is free ( Special AREA )  
Mooney Park at the field is \$5.00 for the weekend.

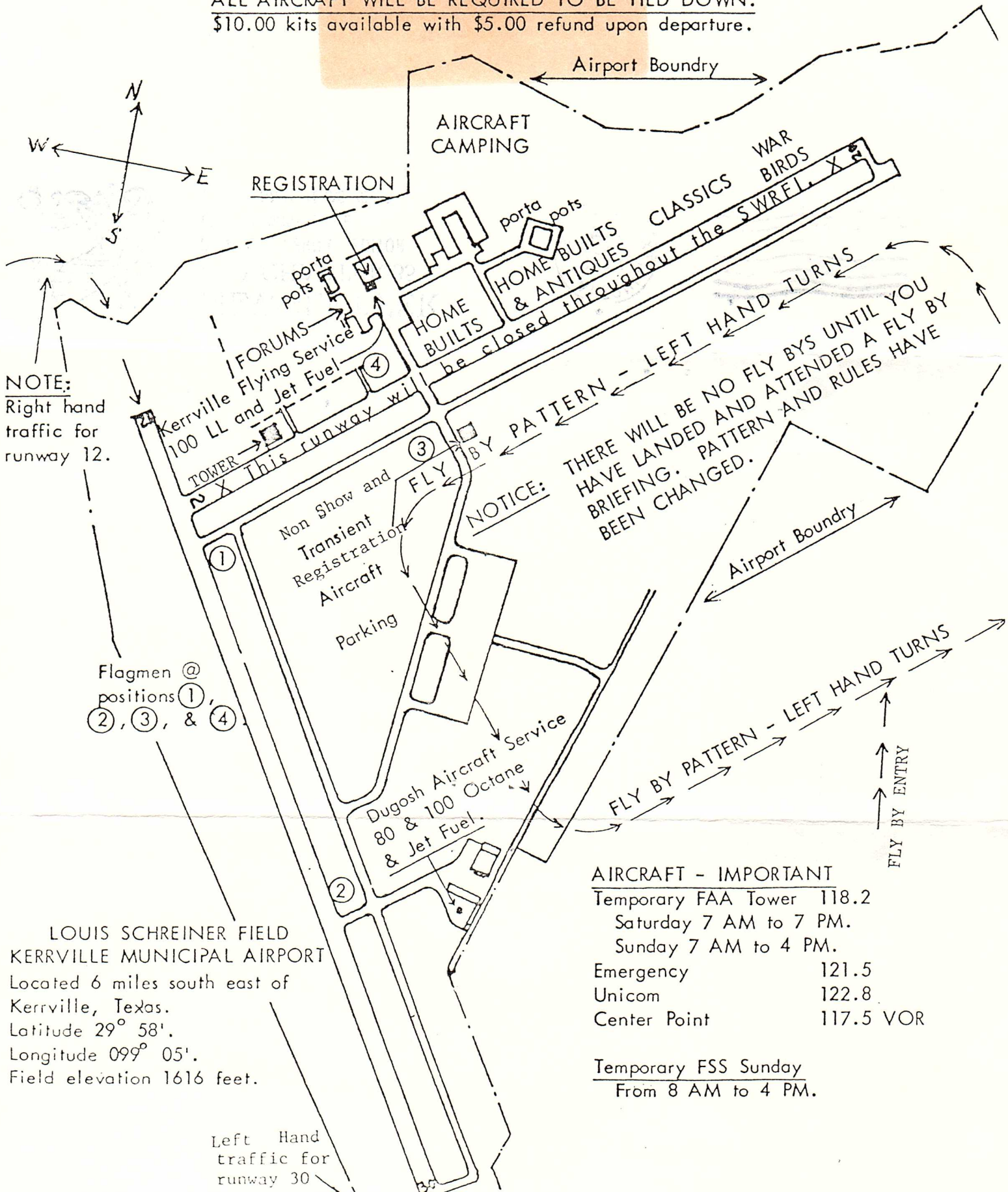

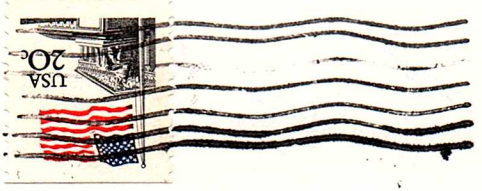
