Anyway, the left main caught in a bad spot in the taxiway, and bent some of the stringers in the left wing. I'm still working with the appraiser for the airport's insurance agency to get the damage paid for. Does anybody know a local shop that does good wing rebuilding here? Please let me know any recommendations.
