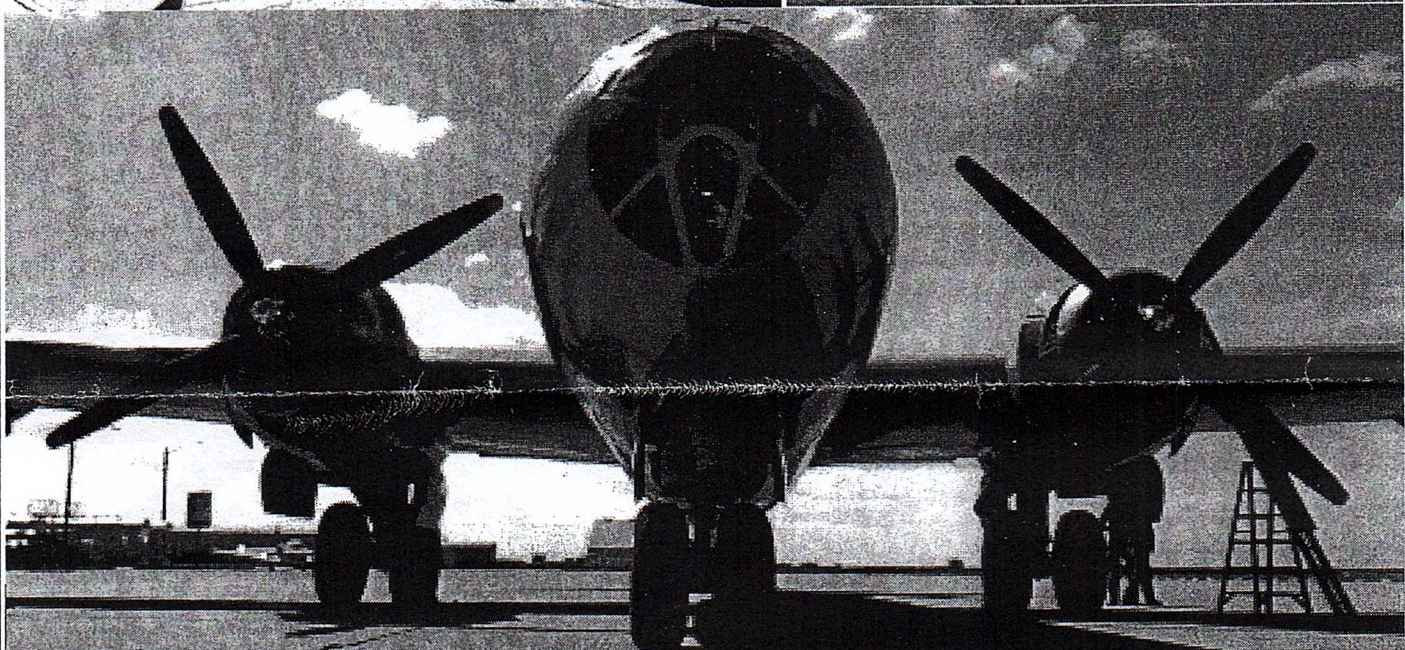
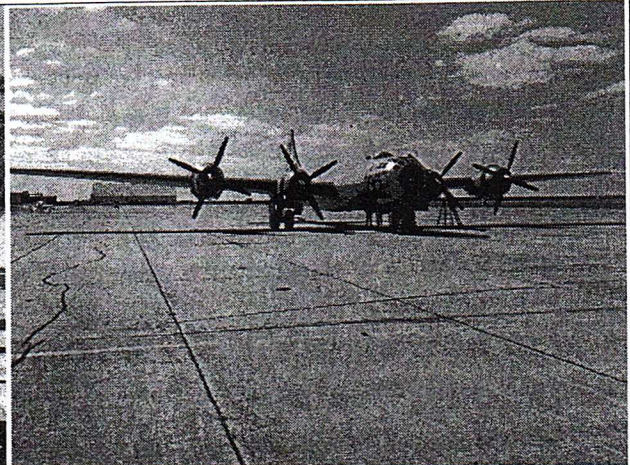
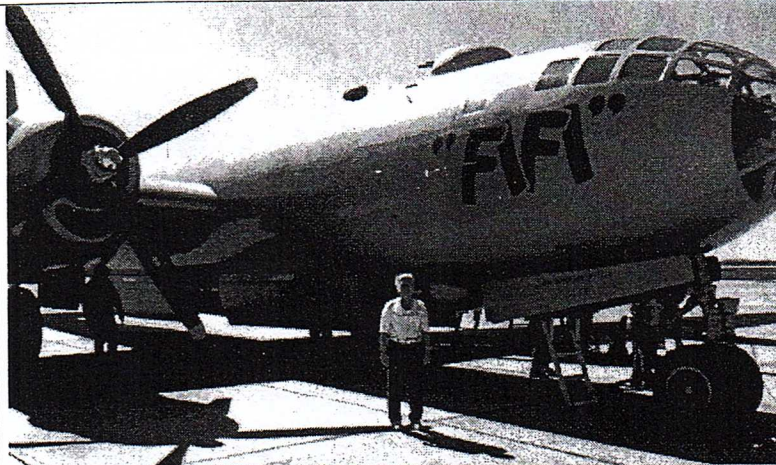
BUILDER'S ACADEMY UPDATE
