KMTW Runway Closures

Manitowoc County airport is doing some work on the runways to include lighting, signs, and taxiways. So there will be runway closures. This is the projected timeline; it is not set in stone. Before you fly, please check in with the FBO (Fixed-Base Operator) or NOTAM (Notice to Airmen) (Originally it was Notice to Air Mission).

April 15 - 16 Runways 07 and 25 will be closed for sign replacement.

April 19 The entire airport will be closed to work on the intersection of both runways.

April 20 - 22 Expect partial closures on the taxiways.

April 23 - June 6 Runway 17 and 35 will be closed for lighting and signs.



NOTAM

NOTAMs represent important things you need to know about your flight before you depart, so they're an integral part of getting a good pre-flight briefing. You can search for NOTAMs on the FAA website's NOTAM search tool or get them from a flight briefer.

NOTAM information is classified into these categories:

- Domestic
- Flight Data Center
- International
- Special Activity Airspace
- Military
