Hangar Door Project

There is still much work to do before winter closes in on us. The following list of tasks need to be completed:

- Install J-Channel above the weather membrane
- Seal the membrane seal at the top of the door with silicone
- Install the side door trim on the Diamond Door
- Paint the old door wooden rails with a second coat of paint
- Break out the small portion of concrete in front of the door to allow Mr. Keller access to run power to his hangar on the West side of the EAA hangar.
- Form up the new concrete apron and schedule a concrete delivery.
- Install the needed vent lines for the furnace. We can discuss a game plan at the meeting this Wednesday evening.
