



UPDATES ON THE HANGAR

We spent some time last weekend cleaning up the EAA Hangar and restoring things back to what they were before we started the bi-fold door installation. Many of the aircraft parts have been hung up on the wall to keep them from being underfoot. In addition, we installed some lift eyebolts and hung the fuselage from the ceiling to create more floor space. The fuselage is double strapped for safety and it can be lowered in a few minutes by about three people.
