Flag Day.....

Celebrating the Flag is believed to

have first originated in 1885. BJ Cigrand, a schoolteacher, arranged for the pupils in the Fredonia, Wisconsin Public School, District 6, to observe June 14 (the 108th anniversary of the official adoption of The Stars and Stripes) as 'Flag Birthday'. Inspired by these three decades of state and local celebrations, Flag Day - the anniversary of the Flag Resolution of 1777, was officially *established* by the Proclamation of President Woodrow Wilson on May 30th, 1916. While Flag Day was celebrated in various communities for years after Wilson's proclamation, it was not until August 3rd, 1949, that President Truman signed an Act of Congress designating **June 14th** of each year as **National Flag Day**.

Meeting adjourned





The purpose of the trip this year was new updated avionics for the RV10. I pretty much decided on dual Garmin GX3's, but was undecided on GTN 650. Wanted to get some hands on. I especially wanted to know about touchscreen in turbulence. How easy are the manual knobs to use instead of touch. I'm used to the trusted 430 and was wondering if the change was worth it. The 430W is still worth about \$7000 so it would be about \$4500 to switch. The Garmin SL 30 is still a great #2 Nav Com and I'll probably just stick with that. I also wanted to know how well the Garmin interfaced with the TruTrak autopilot system since I really didn't want to change out autopilot or servos. So... Lots of classes and workshops. Lots of questions and hands on. Stein, Stein, Stein. Their motto is, "We're not happy until you're broke."

Didn't take a lot of pictures. We did watch the airshow, because of Pat's interest. Same pilots, similar routines. We talked to a few Cub pilots. It's fun to talk to the ones that had a hand in restoration because they seem to know the complete history of their machines and as with mine, they were used as military trainers early in their careers.

Getting my helicopter rating has always been on my bucket list, so we did spend some time at the Safari display. The new model, Safari 500, is tightly cowled as opposed to mostly open like the 400. New options include a turbocharger, which makes it a more realistic RAP altitude performer. As you can see by the embarrassing picture, it's not only the altitude that's the problem. Anyway, Thursday at Busch Gardens, Friday and Saturday at Sun and Fun made for a great outing. Good Flying!
