EAA 402 November 2021 Meeting Minutes

The regular meeting was called to order by President Bernie Volpe who opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag at 1900 hrs. There was a nice turnout. The members present were Tom McFadden, Carl Oblinger, Ralph Brandon, Rollie Bailey, Dave Clum, Bob Marriott, Tom Thompson, Jim Wright, Carl Braddock, Dick Perdue, Dan Glaze, Bernie Volpe, Barney Kemter, Ken Hughes, Bill Corban, George Fackler, Leota Lane, Bruce Lane, Charlie Moore and Scott Kennedy.

President Volpe thanked Barney Kemter for bringing the standing rib roast for dinner. There was a round of applause for Barney.

Secretary's Report: The secretary asked for approval of the October meeting minutes as printed in the November newsletter. Motion was made by Dan Glaze, seconded by Barney Kemter and passed by the members present.

Treasurer's Report: The detailed report, dated November 16, 2021, was presented by Treasurer Scott Kennedy. A summary follows. The starting balance was \$5122.14. Dues Payments received: \$15.00. Donations Received: Utility Fund \$145.00; Christmas dinner payments \$228.00. Expenses paid: Utilities: \$87.36; Reimbursement to Rollie for American Legion services on the Stockport fly-out \$120. Ending balance \$5,302.78 including reserves of \$1876.68 and discretionary funds of \$3426.10. The report was accepted by the members present.

Airport Board Report: Bill Corban

Bill reported that the concrete has been poured for the new hangar row and the fire wall has been erected. The builders are now awaiting steel. Bill said the concrete block firewall caused the loss of two hangar spaces. The floors are sloped toward the rear of the hangars allowing for drainage. The electricity installation in the box hangar has been completed but completion of the hangar is delayed awaiting the overhead door. Bill also noted that the trees in front of the FBO parking lot will be cut down soon in preparation for the building of the new FBO. Someone asked about the status of getting self-serve fuel and George Fackler answered that it is imminent!

Fly-Outs: Rollie Bailey

Rollie reported on the fly-Out November 9th to Greater Portsmouth Regional Airport. Eight planes and nine people went on the outing; Scott Thompson and a neighbor in Scott's Cessna 180; Sam Huff in his Cherokee 160; Roy Hurt in his Mooney; Tom Thompson in his homebuilt "Super Cub;" Chris Anderson in his Cessna 150; Duck Perdue in his Cessna 152; Rollie Bailey in his Cherokee 235 and Bob Erhard in his Cessna 150. Others who desire to sponsor a CAP should do so online or send payment to the treasurer.

New Business

- Bill Corban invited the members to acknowledge Barney Kemter and wish him well. He said Barney will be getting married soon and will be moving to Hudson, Ohio. Barney was asked to fill us in, and Barney said the wedding will be May 14, 2022, and they will close on a house in Hudson on December 15th . Barney said they will move from, and sell their respective, homes in stages.
