A brief meeting was held at the Buckeye Lake Yacht Club in conjunction with our annual holiday banquet. The meeting was called to order just prior to dinner at 6:30 pm by outgoing President Barney Kemter. The president opened the meeting with an invitation to the attendees to recite together the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. **Discussion Item 1:** Determine the amount of reimbursement against Young Eagles credits to request from EAA. Amount earned \$1035. The treasurer will request reimbursement of \$474.35 for legitimate Young Eagles expenses for which we have records and receipts. The treasurer will submit the request for reimbursement. The secretary has enquired about transferring the balance of our credits to another chapter although it is thought the credits expired December 31<sup>st</sup>.

**Discussion Item 2:** Determine the format for our Young Eagles program going forward. We may need to change format from rallies to individual schedules because the Young Eagles Pilot population within the chapter continues to decrease due to aging and changes in life situations, and because there is only one airplane available for rent at VTA. The YE coordinator (Tom) will take a survey to see who will be available to fly YE this year. Two rallies have already been scheduled as indicated in the regular meeting minutes. The possibility of pre-registration, perhaps on-line, was discussed at some length but no decision made.

**Discussion Item 3:** The Civil Air Patrol has requested several considerations from the chapter. 1) 2<sup>nd</sup> Lt Green has asked if the CAP could use our building when they are having orientation flights. Barney motioned that we allow this. Bob seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

2) 2<sup>nd</sup> Lt Green also asked if we could possibly provide one or more special Young Eagles events just for the CAP cadets. Barney made a motion that we plan one YE event for CAP in addition to the two general events. The motion was seconded by Ken and passed unanimously by the board members.

**Discussion Item 4:** Funding for youth to EAA Air Academy was discussed. It is too late to use 2018 YE credits as they have expired. Another source would be the Forrest Garey Memorial fund of \$930 which was dedicated for YE and/or youth education. Barney made a motion that we present the idea of using this money for sponsoring a youth to the Air Academy to the general membership. Rollie seconded this motion and the board members passed it.

**Discussion Item 5:** Shall we apply for a Ray Aviation Scholarship again this year? Application to be an administering chapter must be in by January 31<sup>st</sup>. Applications for a potential scholar must be in by March 15<sup>th</sup>. Barney Kemter is our existing coordinator and he has volunteered to write the application again this year.

Motion to adjourn was made by Ken Hughes and seconded by Robert Marriott and the meeting was adjourned at 1730.
