Honor the Service Event, Vietnam Memorial—August 27th

EAA402 will be participating in the Honor the Service Event, Vietnam Memorial, at the Newark-Heath Airport, Treneff Field, on Saturday, August 27th. This is a huge public event at the airport sponsored by the Friendship Club of Licking County and will be attended by thousands of visitors. The event will feature the AVTT Traveling Wall and several warbirds!

The chapter will have an exhibitor’s booth within the event perimeter where members will meet the public and hand out information about aviation, EAA, and the chapter. The 402 will also be offering small diecast planes, printed Tees, and other merchandise for a suggested donation. Donations received will aid our aviation scholarship fund.

The chapter will also be opening the clubhouse to the public on the morning of the event and offering coffee and donuts to visitors. Signs will be placed on travel routes between parking and event areas to alert the public to the open house and the clubhouse location.

Help from chapter members is needed to set up and man the booth during the day and tear down and put things away afterward. Help is needed at the clubhouse during the Open House to meet the public, serve coffee and donuts, and hand out information.

The regular meeting, held in the clubhouse, was called to order by President Bernie Volpe. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag at 1900 hrs. There were seventeen members, and four visitors present. Visitors were the Rowell daughters, Lila and Ava, David R. Turner, Trevor Large and Betsy Kays. Betsy Kays Joined the chapter after the meeting.

Introductions:

- Trevor Large introduced himself. Trevor was a Young Eagle a number of times and flew with Rollie and Bill. Trevor is now a student pilot and owns a Kitfox which is hangered across from Bill Corban's hangar.
- David Turner is a 22,800-hour pilot, including military, helicopter, corporate and much more but is retired from flying because of medical reasons. David was re-introduced to flight when he flew with Larry Arnold today. Larry told him of the chapter and David came to the meeting to see what it is all about.

Secretary Report: There were no additions or corrections to the minutes and therefore the minutes of the June 2022 meeting stand as published in the July newsletter. The secretary displayed the first page of the July newsletter on the TV screen and pointed out the GOLD banner we received from EAA and also pointed out that the chapter is in its 51st year of existence.

Treasurer's Report: Scott Kennedy, Chapter Treasurer, presented the financial report dated ...Starting Balance \$3576.00. VFW 1060 donated \$600 to the Young Eagles Program. \$154 in dues and miscellaneous was received. \$34 was paid for utilities and \$125 was paid for rental of the portable toilet used at the YE Rally on June 11th. The closing balance is \$4269.00.

Airport Board Report: Rollie Bailey gave his report from the Airport Board meeting held earlier this evening. Rollie reported that the Board mostly discussed the planning for the up-coming Honor the Service, Vietnam Memorial event that will be held on the airport on August 27th. George Fackler also spoke of the "people movers" that his company and Lynd and Dawes will be supplying.

Fly Out Report: Rollie Bailey, Fly-Out coordinator, gave the report on a fly-out of 5 planes to TSO on Saturday, July 16th.

Old Business

- There was brief discussion about the chapter's involvement with the Honor the Service event. The chapter will have a booth in the main area of the event and will offer T-shirts and die cast airplanes for sale. There is also a possibility that we will have an open house at the clubhouse that day and offer coffee, drinks, donuts, and pancakes. The chapter board of directors will work out the details and ask for volunteers to run the open house.
- Flying Start/Eagle Flights. Tony Rowell was presented with the week pass for two to Airventure that he won at the Flying Start event in May this year.

- Golden propeller award. Dave Hall reported that Greg Kays is making the wood base for the propeller.


New Business

- Young Eagles Rally September 10th. Tom used the screen to lead the discussion and confirm volunteers for certain jobs including pilots. Construction has caused changes in the way we can do this event. Need to determine where to put the portable toilet and the food service. Visitor parking was discussed, and George Fackler suggested we use the fenced-in lot to the west of the construction area for this.
- Ken presented the BOD proposal to replenish the merchandise supplies. Using the screen, Ken showed the proposed order information, and the members accepted the proposal. The cost of T-Shirts would be \$516.25; cost of "Runway" model planes will be \$240.00; cost of better-quality models to raffle will be \$100.00. The planes will come from DARON and are imports. Therefore, there is a shipping and handling charge of \$78.30. The shirts will come from GotGear-4-U which is a local company. Ken will order the models and Tom will order the shirts.

Announcements: Bernie announced that Kenny Bing soloed about 5 days ago. The members applauded.

The president adjourned the meeting at approximately 2015.

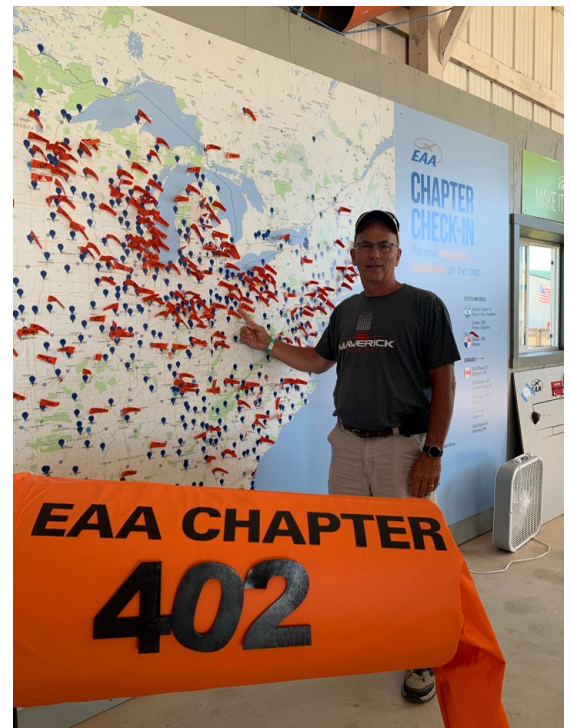
