Aviation training is an ongoing program at Seigel High School these classes are focused on getting their

students to the point of passing the written test for either the “Private Pilots License” or the “Drone Pilots License” as administered by the FAA. By passing these tests this opens up funds to the school from the STEM funding system from the Federal Government. Some of the students have gone on to work toward their “Commercial Pilots License” with MTSU classes after graduation. Their Instructor/Mentor is Scott Myers at Seigel High School. Having met and worked with some of

his students it's quickly apparent that these students have taken seriously this opportunity to learn and visualize that a career in aviation is a distinct possibility for them. I talked to Scott about their program and had a look at their facilities which I found to be equipped much better than I thought they might be at a High School level. Up to and including a full motion Redbird simulator along with some stationary simulators that can be programed to fly like a C172 to F18's a wide performance envelope!

They can also fly drones with photography packages such as used in power line inspection, insurance claim inspection or real estate videos to display the features on properties for

sale. They have even been flown in cross country flight competitions that the school has competed in.

In 2023 there will be 100 student positions open to this program as Seigel High is a "Magnet School" for the school district in Rutherford County. The focus of the program is to help the students pass their written exams and develop peer discipline and encourage teamwork with their fellow students in the program. To date 155~ students have passed their FAA written test in this the fourth largest school district in Tennessee.

The school also has programs in Veterinary Technician, Construction and Automotive Technology for students wanting to develop marketable skills.

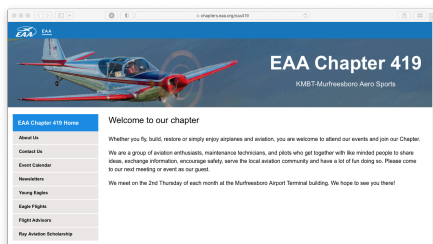
The speaker this month is Bob Hope, he will be speaking on warbirds and rumor has it there will be great visuals with his presentation!
