Lloyd was born in Wellsville, Kansas. He attended Kansas State College (K State) in Manhattan, Kansas. He studied engineering and architecture. In 1918, he left school to enlist in the Naval Reserve in San Diego. He learned to fly Curtiss N-9 seaplanes.

During the mid—1920s he was hired as a mechanic by Matty Laird, giving him his first exposure to fixed-wing aircraft manufacturing. In 1925, Lloyd and Walter Beech teamed up with Clyde Cessna to form the Travel Air Manufacturing Company. He left in 1927 to form his own company, Stearman Aircraft Company. It was there that he built the Stearman C2 and C3, and designed other biplanes for mail and cargo delivery, observation and training. In the early 1930s, Lloyd became president of Lockheed Aircraft (Lockheed Martin) and designed agricultural aircraft. In 1948, more than 4,345 Stearman aircraft were used in agricultural flying.

Lloyd was inducted into the National Aviation Hall of Fame in Dayton, Ohio in 1989.



The Army used the PT13D and the Navy used the N2S-4 models for trainers. They were known at the “Yellow Peril” because of its tricky ground handling characteristics. They were also bought by Argentine, Brazil, Canada and the Philippines. The versatile plane was used for training, dog fighting, ground support and later for cropdusting, wing walking and aerobatics at air shows.

The Jeppesen Employee Flight Association (JEFA) has already committed two planes, and at least two pilots, for the Sunday rally.

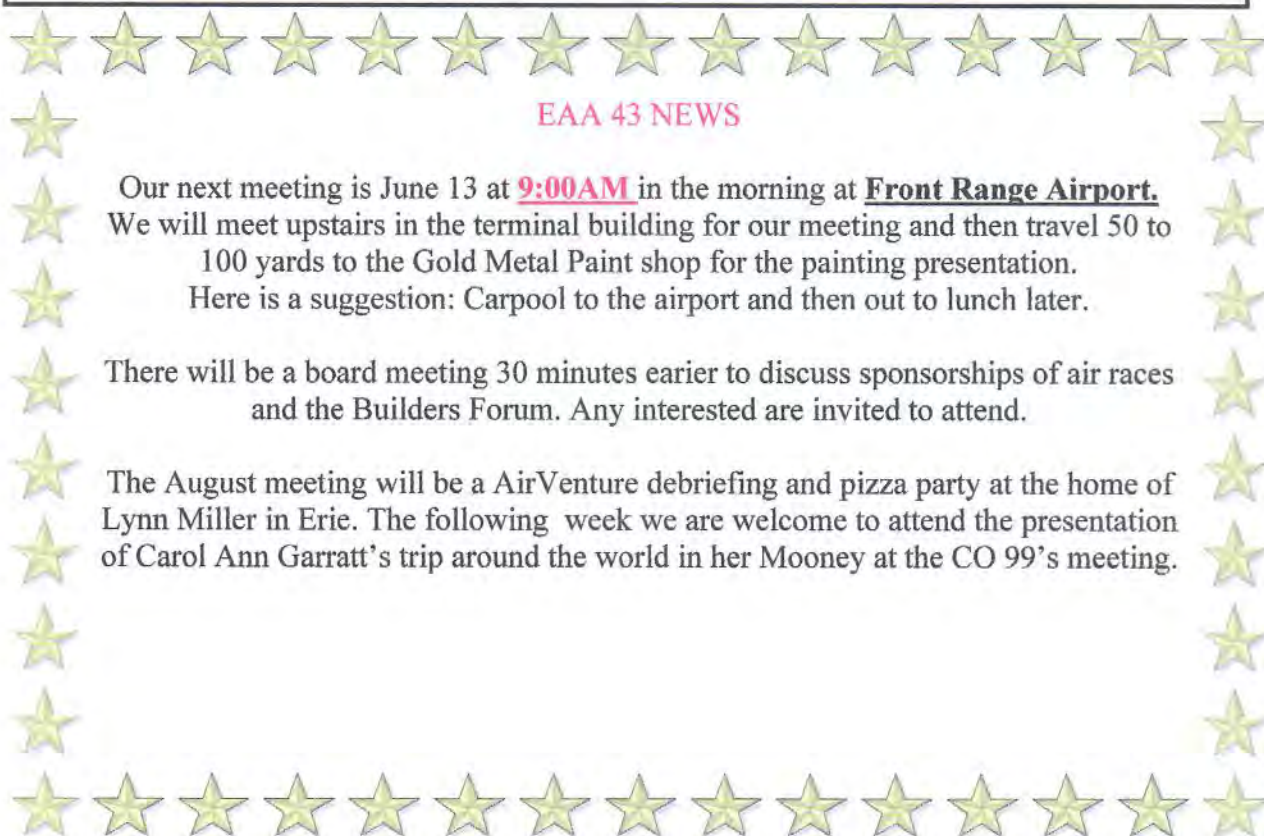

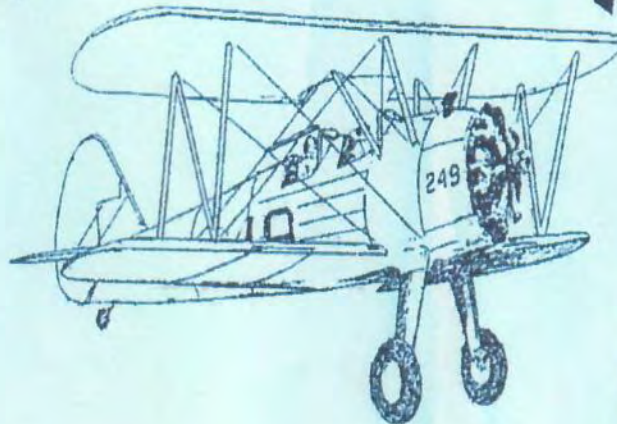
