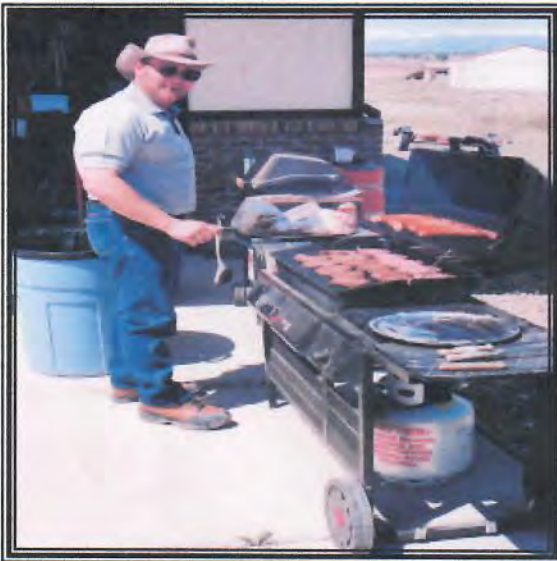

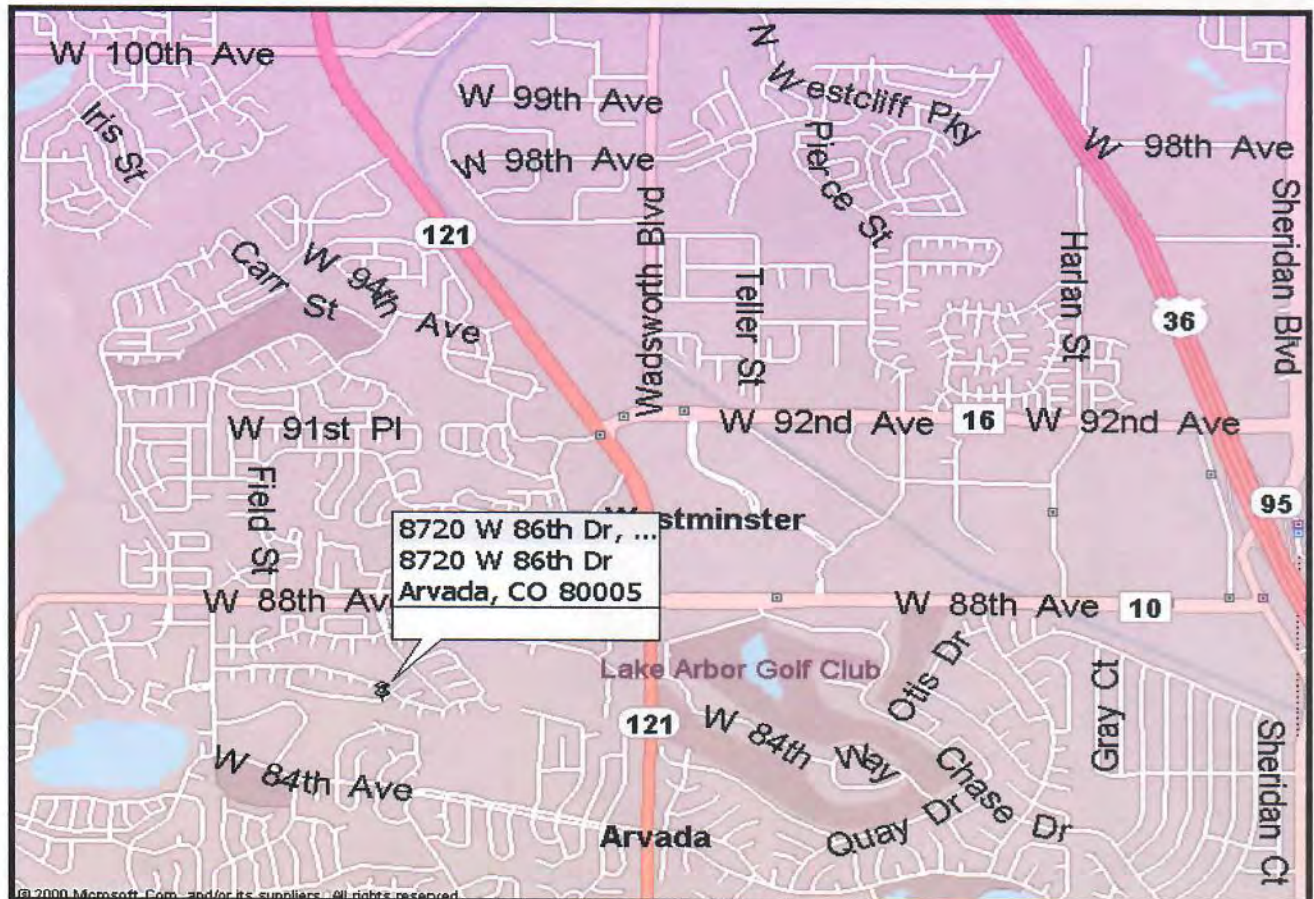
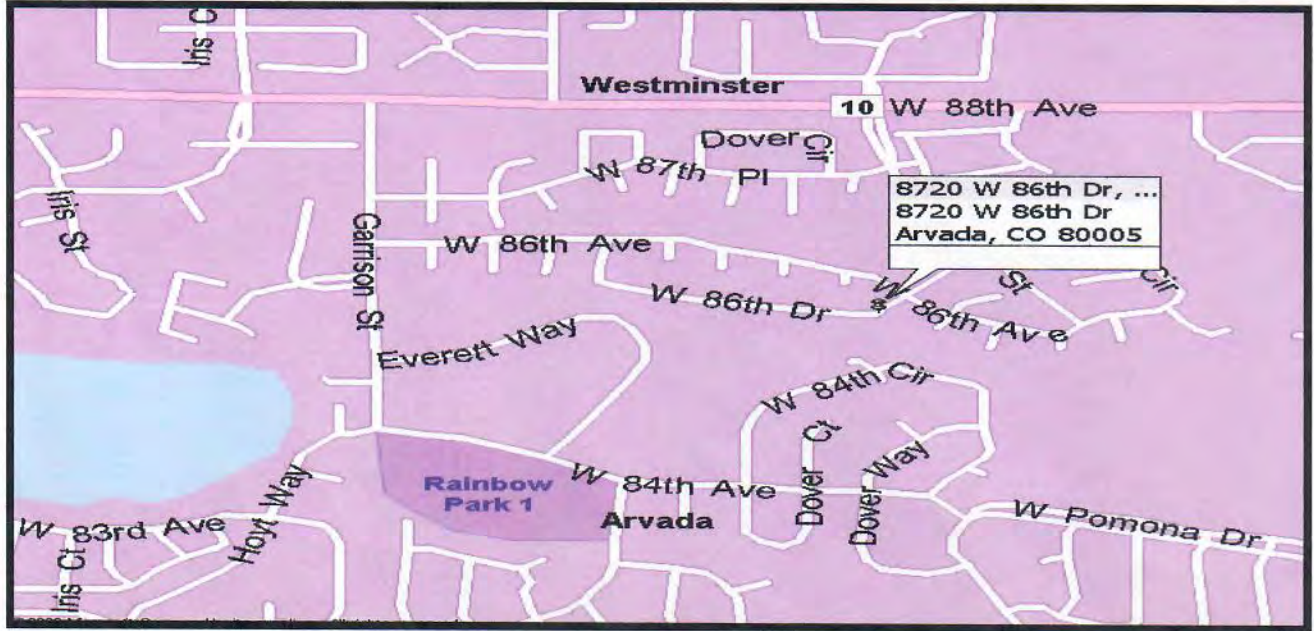
Chapter 43 Annual Picnic at Don Coleman's Hanger
