New Business: *Bill Mitchell* wants to see the YE program go to the next level. Someone in the chapter should build a simulator for the younger kids to play with at the YE events.

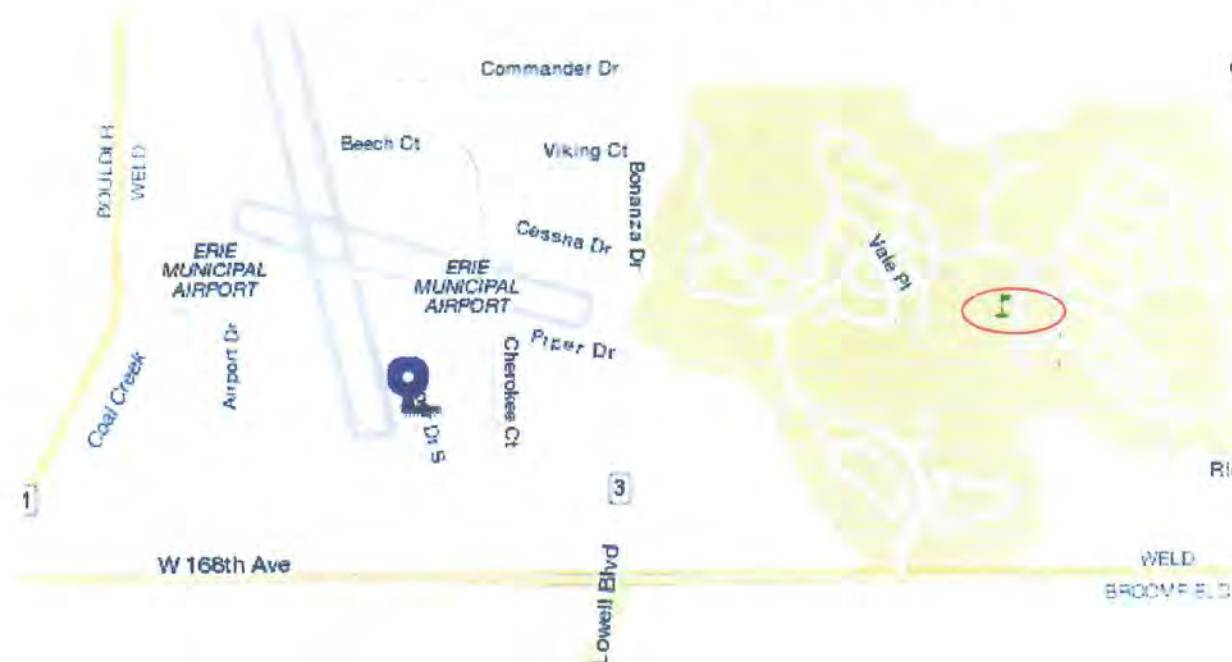

Pilot's Tip by Pilot Workshop

Military Operations Area (MOA)

Pilots flying IFR will be kept clear of conflicting traffic by ATC. While VFR pilots are not prohibited from flying in MOAs, they certainly should keep an active scan for traffic. The local Air Traffic Sector or Flight Service Station will be a valuable resource as to their current activity. Military aircraft are probably not looking for you as actively as you can be looking for them. Always check your current aeronautical charts. The areas are identified by type and identifying number or name, their effective altitudes, their operating times, weather conditions during which the area is in operation and the voice call of the controlling agency.

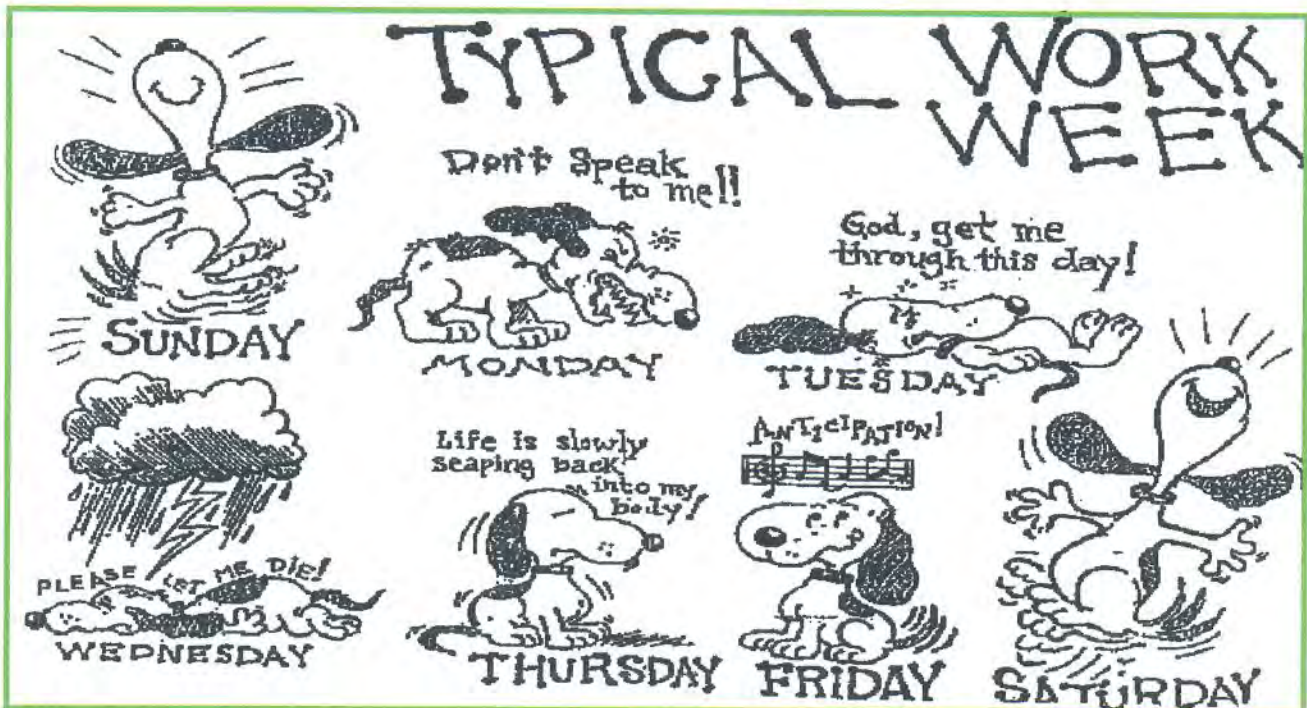

He is one of the few who have had the opportunity to fly both aircraft. With over 11,000 total hours, 8,000 in military aircraft (including 1,600 hours in the U-2 and more than 600 hours in the SR-71) and an Air Force career that encompassed the world he has stories that just don't end.

His military assignments ran from flying combat missions in F84's during the Korean War to Chief of Staff of the Fifteenth Air Force at March AFB, CA. When you hear him talk you will know immediately which airplane was his true love. But don't take this the wrong way, Pat is truly one of us. He retired in the mid 80's and now lives in Colorado Springs. He flew a Loving's Love for many years before donating it to the Sun'n Fun museum and now flies a Lancair.
